#### Main Course (General English):

#### One-to-one lessons (Specialist subject):

- The primary focus is on English for your specialist subject.
- You will be asked to complete a Needs Analysis in advance of your course. In this you will state what you wish to learn, and your teacher will create a study plan based on this.
- 5 x 45-minute lessons.
