# THE LOCATION



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


## IPSWICH SCHOOL

Dating back from circa 1399, Ipswich school in the heart of Ipswich with a beautiful campus built around the field with two sports sites minutes away from the main school, and students enjoy 60 acres of open space and sports pitches. Ipswich is Suffolk's county town, thought to be one of England's oldest towns, if not the oldest. In recent years it has also been named England's cleanest town. It retains excellent road and rail links to London, Cambridge, the Midlands and the North, with London's Liverpool Street station being just over an hour away.

The town has a vibrant community of about 150,000 inhabitants, who enjoy a beautifully regenerated waterfront area with many restaurants and leisure facilities, a championship football club, a lively theatre and two multiplex cinemas. providing a safe and secure environment in which to experience British culture. Recently voted as one of the top cultural hubs in the UK, Ipswich is the perfect location to explore and immerse yourself in English Life.

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

# ACCOMMODATION

## WESTWOOD HOUSE

Westwood House offers attractive boarding facilities within a beautiful Victorian mansion set in picturesque wooded grounds, just a 5-minute walk from the main school site. The house is designed to provide a comfortable and welcoming environment for students.

### Accommodation Options:

- ▶ Rooms range from single to three-bed dorms.
- ▶ Shared toilet and washing facilities are conveniently located between rooms.
- ▶ Separate access is provided to male and female dorms, ensuring privacy and security.

### Facilities and Amenities:

- ▶ Onsite common room for relaxation and socializing.
- ▶ Dining area where students can enjoy meals together.
- ▶ Activity space and astroturf sports pitches for recreational activities.
- ▶ Dedicated areas specifically for Group Leaders to manage and oversee student activities.



## SIXTH FORM HOUSE

Sixth Form House is a modern, newly refurbished building located right next to the main school site, offering both convenience and comfort. The house features a warm and welcoming lounge, a TV room, and a fully equipped kitchen, creating a home-like atmosphere for students.

## Excursion Details:


### Full-Day Excursions:


