





# **INCOME 2025**


operational income (tithes and offerings) (giving is the total from all locations: Toowoomba, Brisbane, & Online)



The majority of our income is from the *faithful giving of our people*. Your regular gifts help enable the ongoing ministry and mission of our church to help *make*, *mature*, & *multiply* disciples. Please note that the average monthly gift is simply that—an average! There is a wide-range of regular gifts that people discern in accordance with their resources.

Please note that more detailed information regarding our projected 2025 income and expenses is detailed in the Annual Report (available on our website).

Our **anticipated** shortfall is now \$44,631 (about 6% under budget). We're hoping (and praying) to completely reduce this gap before the end of the year. This will especially enable us to fill and resource all of our needed roles.



With that in mind, we're inviting those who do not currently give regularly, to consider doing so. Further, regular givers may like to consider a special one-off gift to reduce the gap.
