For each of our focus areas, we have a three fold pattern of prayer:

- **Thank You.** Expressing our gratitude to God for his faithfulness and provision.
- **Sorry.** Repenting for our sin and the ways we fall short. Includes lament for the brokenness of our lives and world—the damage we do/experience.
- **Please.** Seeking God's will for our lives, church, and world. Entrusting our requests to God and trusting his will.

Persecuted Church & Global Mission

God is active in the world, drawing people to himself through his Son and in the power of his Spirit. Ever since the inception of the church, Christians have faced persecution. For more information on how to pray for the persecuted church, visit Open Doors.

THANK YOU

- For the faithful witness of Christians across time and place, especially for those facing persecution.
- For the significant growth of the church in many places in the world in which it is dangerous to believe.
- For how the gospel is going out to remote and isolated places. Give thanks for how the Bible is being brought to people in different languages and dialects.
- That even in the face of persecution *that you are present with every believer.*

SORRY

- For when we forget the plight of the persecuted church.
- For our inconsistency of praying for the mission of the global church, especially in those places that face persecution and the threat of persecution for their faith.
- For when we fail to grasp the significance of the Gospel opportunities that we have in Australia and on our frontlines.
- We lament all forms of persecution of Christians and the church.

PLEASE

- Please protect and give strength to those who face any type of persecution and suffering. Provide for them according to their needs.
- Protect, nurture, and give strength to the underground church in Algeria, Libya, Iran, Afghanistan, and China.
- Release Christians who face false blasphemy accusations in Pakistan.
- For peace and safety for Christians in Nigeria facing hostile attacks.
- For perseverance for those Muslim-background believers in Iraq.
- Move the global church to be generous to those who are most vulnerable.
- To sustain believers who have been physically harmed and/or isolated for becoming followers of Jesus.
- For boldness and wisdom for believers to share their faith and that people would come to Christ.
- Move us from apathy to lives shaped by faithful and persistent prayer.

Frontlines including Workplaces

Our work, places of work, and those with whom we work, all matter to God. This term we are praying with a focus on *carers*.

THANK YOU

- For the dignity of work and for the ways in which we can serve God's mission through what we do, where we serve, and with whom we work.
- Thank you for the opportunities through work we have to model godly character, make good work, minister grace and love, mould culture, be a mouthpiece for truth and justice, and be messengers of the gospel.
- For the multitude of people who serve behind the scenes, often in areas of work that are critical for our society.
- For those committed to training, apprenticing, and developing people.
- For the carers of family members, aged people, and for those with disabilities. Thank you for the generosity, compassion, and care.
- For the many Aged Care and Home providers, and for the dignity, care, and respite they provide.

SORRY

- For when we neglect our workplaces, fail to pray for our colleagues, or are hesitant to embrace Gospel opportunities before us.
- For when we skimp on our commitments or let colleagues down.
- For when we evaluate people (and ourselves) by the work that we do.
- For the ways we are blind to the service of others through their work.
- We lament the brokenness of some workplaces, the challenge it is for many, and imperfect systems.
- For how we are quick to forget the unseen work of caring done in homes.
- For how we undervalue the work of caring, and its demands on families and workers emotionally, physically, and financially.
- For our failure to show compassion and be flexible in friendship, with those who have additional caring obligations.

PLEASE

- Help us to see how God is at work on our frontlines, in and through us.
- Give wisdom and patience for carers negotiating the aged care system which often involves a patchwork of services, portals, specialists, and support programs that can be confusing and frustrating.
- For God to sustain the emotional and physical wellbeing of carers as they carry a heavy load often in the isolation of their homes.

- For friends and family to find ways to nurture and sustain those carrying a burden of care.
- For those who are waiting for assessments and care packages for loved ones.
- For patience, wisdom, strength, and joy in the day to day care, especially in navigating frequent medical appointments, and financial and physical demands of caring.
- For those who feel alone and restricted because of the onus of their caring obligations.
- For those negotiating all the hurdles of financial and personal challenges involved in seeking out respite and long term at home and long-term care places.
- For informed and compassionate care from all medical, allied health, and nursing workers.
- For those starting placements and seeking work in Aged Care and Disability support work, for the ability to do their work in challenging contexts with patience and love.
- For the Aged Care and Home Providers in Toowoomba and Brisbane, that they would be able to offer and supply affordable services with dignity and respect.
- For a greater interest and understanding of the pressures people face on all their frontlines.
- For the fruit of the Spirit - love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, gentleness, and self-control - to grow and be present for those giving and receiving care.

AREA THREE: EVANGELISM

Making Disciples of Jesus

THANK YOU

- For all who have witnessed to us, prayed for us, and discipled us in our faith. Also for the privilege we share in doing the same.
- For those in our church (young, old, and in between) who have become followers of Jesus or come back to faith last year.
- For the wonderful opportunities to share the Gospel with many people who don't yet know Jesus, at both Carols and Christmas Services.
- For the thirty-six people who explored faith at Alpha in 2025. Pray that they would each trust in Jesus as their Lord and Saviour, and that the Lord would

multiply the witness of new Christians.

- For the people who don't yet know Jesus, who have come along to the Church Plant in Brisbane.
- For those currently exploring Christianity or considering coming along to Alpha in February.
- For the opportunities on all of our frontlines to both show and share the Good News of Jesus.
- That we have incredible freedom in Australia to proclaim the Gospel without the fear of persecution.
- For the growing openness to faith we are witnessing in our community.
- That many—people who are not yet believers—who feel welcome to join us on Sundays (in-person and online).

- Embolden us with the Spirit to recognise Gospel opportunities, have

the wisdom in knowing what to say, and the courage to actually speak.

- For God to prepare the hearts to whom we go that they might be receptive to inviting and the Good News.
- Give us eyes to see who we might invite to Alpha, courage to invite, and that the Spirit would be preparing hearts now to accept an invitation.
- For the Alpha team, as they prepare to come alongside those considering faith or returning to faith.
- For continued conversations with family, friends, and neighbours who came along to Carols and Christmas Services - for wisdom, compassion, and gentleness in pointing to Jesus.
- That we will embrace the many opportunities in Aged Care to share the Good News and invite people to put their trust in the Lord Jesus.

- Help us to onboard new leaders well and that many people will accept the invitation to become leaders this year.
- That leadership.local will be an effective way of developing our leaders, encouraging them in Christ, and enabling them to collaborate.
- Help us to grow our giving to meet the needs of our budget this year.
- For those entering into discernment towards ordination: that they will take the steps where God leads.
- That Justin (new Assistant Minister) and Jacqueline will settle in well and feel at home quickly.

- For provision of roles - especially a Church Planter.

- *Discipleship & Training:* For our small groups to flourish and multiply. That there would be small groups that would suit all demographics, particularly young families, those connecting online, and in Brisbane.
- *Discipleship & Training:* That our small group leaders would be encouraged and strengthened in faith, as they host and disciple others week by week.
- *Discipleship & Training:* For more volunteers to join the library team representing all ages, and that all those who use the library would grow as followers of Jesus.
- *Discipleship & Training:* For people to respond to the invitation to attend the Ridley courses this year, beginning with *The Gospel of John*.
- *Discipleship & Training:* That we would be active in proclaiming the Gospel on our frontline of work. That people would be equipped to see how God is at work through their work, especially through the Centre for Work + Faith.
- *Discipleship & Training:* Use the Prayer Nights to help us partake in God's mission in the world. Connect more people into regular prayer ministries such as groups, chats, and lists.
- *Discipleship & Training:* That our Newcomer's lunches would be effective and helpful in linking people into our life together.
- *Discipleship & Training:* For wisdom and insight for the Alpha team, in facilitating open and warm group conversations, and pointing people to Jesus.
- *Operations:* For more gardeners to lighten the load of the current team and replace those getting too old to manage the physical work.
- *Operations:* For more people to serve in with the Operations team.
- *Operations:* For the new leader of mowing, and for the mowing team to grow.
- *Operations:* That as a church, we would all give generously and sacrificially of our finances, intentionally committing to building God's kingdom, together.
- *Governance & Parish Council:* That we would be good stewards in all areas, faithful in governance, and wise in seeking God's will for our future.
- *Mission Partnerships:* That our vision for those who don't know Christ in our community, Australia, and other nations of the world, will be enlarged.

Multiplying Gospel Workers & Communities

Identifying, encouraging, developing, and sending Gospel workers has long been part of the mission of our church. Pray for the multiplication of Gospel workers, and the multiplication of disciple-making communities - beginning with the Church Plant in Salisbury, Brisbane.

- *Church Plant:* For the opportunity to not only nurture disciple-making disciples but also to multiple disciple-making communities.
- *Church Plant:* For the community God is nurturing and those who will come to hear the Gospel through the church plant in Brisbane.
- *Church Plant:* For the extraordinary number of doors that the Lord has opened, including a core planting group, permission from the bishops, a venue, and also an interim church plant coordinator. Also for the

financial resources, systems, and pathways needed to plant.

- *Church Plant:* For a wonderful start to gathering together in Brisbane to worship the Lord, and the generosity of the core team leading week by week.
- *Church Plant:* For the diversity of generations that the Lord has brought along, including a number of families.
- *Church Plant:* For the generosity of people from Toowoomba, supporting and assisting gaps in serving, particularly in children's and music ministry.
- *Church Plant:* For the ways in which other doors are opening (and being identified) to plant or revitalise in the future.
- *Gospel Workers:* For the generosity and support towards the training fund.
- *Gospel Workers:* For the growing number of people enquiring about gospel work and those in the process towards ordination.
- *Gospel Workers:* For the partnership with Ridley College, in resourcing a coaching group for those in the process towards ordination.
- *Gospel Workers:* For all who have been raised up for ministry and sent out.
- *Gospel Workers:* That we have financial resources—through the generosity of God's people—to support various ministry roles.
- *Gospel Workers:* For the daily faithfulness in prayer of so many people as we look to God to provide more workers for our various vacant roles.

SORRY

- For when we have not listened to how the Spirit is moving us to participate in God's mission.
- For when we lack courage to step into the Gospel opportunities that the Lord has opened up.
- For relying on our own efforts more than prayer, especially as we seek to live out our mission and see that the vision that God has set on our hearts come to life.
- For when we have failed to pray that God would raise up and send workers for the harvest.
- For when we've missed opportunities to identify Gospel Workers or prioritise the development of those who have potential as Gospel Workers.

PLEASE

- *Church Plant:* Continued favour by all stakeholders and for continuing good relationships. That the plant will be fruitful in making new disciples and also helping others reconnect to faith.
- *Church Plant:* That we would have all of the staff resources necessary to support the Church Plant in Brisbane as part of our church as a whole.
- *Church Plant:* Grow the core of people serving in the Church Plant. Particularly pray for more people to serve in children's ministry and music.
- *Church Plant:* For wisdom in discerning other opportunities to plant or revitalise.
- *Gospel Workers:* For those who are being called into leadership roles, that they would be wise and discerning in

heeding the call. Bring them mature Christians who can give them guidance and perspective. Give those who are called, courage to take the next steps to answer God's calling.

- *Gospel Workers:* That we would continue to identify, support, and encourage people in exploring a call to Gospel work - be that in the local church, as missionaries, or as chaplains.
- *Gospel Workers:* That we will be able to employ ordained ministers-in-training in the coming years, along with ordained ministers for the church plant and other potential plants or church revitalisations.
- *Gospel Workers:* For the provision of a Church Planter who has a heart for teaching, pastoring, and leadership. May they have a great burden for the people of Brisbane (particularly Salisbury and Moorooka), long to see the lost saved, be excited about joining in with what God is already doing, and be faithful in pastoring God's people. Please remove any barrier that would prevent them from applying.
- *Gospel Workers:* For those who are called to become ordained ministers, whether they are still discerning or already in training for ordination, that they will be strengthened and equipped for their calling. That God will sustain and protect them so that they are sure of and committed to their calling. That in their formation, they are given excellent teaching and guidance, to shape them to become good leaders and carers for the communities they will serve.

The Lord cares for the people we live amongst and our nation. Pray we would be faithful in serving the Lord on our frontlines, and committed to contributing to and praying for our city and our nation.
