

Privacy Policy for Onytecx

Effective Date: January 21, 2022

1. Introduction

Onytecx (“we,” “us,” “our,” or “Onytecx”) operates the website onytecx.com (the “Site”). We respect your privacy and are committed to protecting your personal information. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard your information when you visit or use the Site. By accessing or using the Site, you accept and agree to this Privacy Policy.

2. Information We Collect

We may collect the following categories of information:

a. Personal Information You Provide

- Name
- Email address
- Postal address
- Phone number
- Billing / payment information (if you make a purchase)
- Other information you submit in contact forms, surveys, or correspondence

b. Automatically Collected Information

When you use the Site, we (or third-party services) may collect certain information automatically, including:

- Device information (e.g. hardware model, operating system, browser type)
- IP address
- Usage data (pages you visit, time spent, links clicked)
- Cookies and similar tracking technologies

c. Third-Party Sources

We may receive information from third parties (e.g. analytics providers, advertising networks) to supplement data we collect directly.

3. How We Use Your Information

We use personal information for purposes including:

- To provide, operate, and maintain the Site
- To improve, personalize, and expand our services
- To respond to inquiries, questions, or requests
- To process transactions and send confirmations
- To send newsletters, marketing or promotional materials (if you opt in)
- To monitor and analyze usage and trends
- For fraud detection, security, and preventing abuse
- To comply with legal obligations

4. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

We use cookies, beacons, tags, and similar technologies to track user activity and collect certain information. You can control cookie preferences through your browser settings. Be aware that disabling cookies may limit functionality of the Site.

5. Sharing and Disclosure of Information

We may share information with:

- **Service Providers & Vendors** — third parties that help us operate the Site or provide services (e.g. payment processors, hosting, analytics)
- **Advertising / Marketing Partners** — for delivering relevant ads (if applicable)
- **Legal and Safety Obligations** — when required by law or to protect rights, safety, property
- **Business Transfers** — in the event of merger, acquisition, or sale of assets

We do **not** sell your personal information to unrelated third parties (unless you give us explicit consent or where required by law).

6. Data Security

We implement reasonable technical, administrative, and organizational measures to protect personal data from unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction.

However, no method of transmission over the Internet or electronic storage is 100% secure; we cannot guarantee absolute security.

7. Data Retention

We retain personal information only as long as necessary for the purposes described in this policy, or as required by law. We may also retain and use anonymized or aggregated data indefinitely.

8. Your Rights and Choices

Depending on your jurisdiction, you may have rights such as:

- Access: request a copy of personal data we hold
- Correction: ask us to correct inaccurate or incomplete data
- Deletion: ask us to delete your personal data (subject to exceptions)
- Restrict processing: limit how we use your data
- Data portability: request transfer of your data to another party
- Opt-out / unsubscribe: from marketing communications
- Opt-out of sale (if applicable)

If you wish to exercise any of these rights, contact us using the information below. We may require verification of your identity before fulfilling requests.

9. Children's Privacy

The Site is not intended for children under the age of 13 (or higher, depending on local law). We do not knowingly collect personal data from children. If you become aware that a child has provided us information, please contact us and we will take steps to delete it.

10. International Transfers

If you are located outside the country where Onytecx is established, your data may be transferred, processed, or stored in jurisdictions that may have different data protection laws. By using the Site, you consent to such transfers.
