## Why forgiveness?

- Forgiveness is central to our faith. (Eph 1:7, Isa 1:18; 55:7, Ps 103:10-14, Acts 10:43, Rom 8:1, Col 1:13-14; 2:13-15, 1 Pet 23:17-18; 2:21-25)
- Forgiveness is central to relationships.

### What forgiveness is not.

- Forgiveness is not removal of consequences.
- Forgiveness is not instant reconciliation/restoration.
- Forgiveness is not a one-time act.
- Forgiveness is not easy.

### What forgiveness is.

- Forgiveness is the decision to give up your right to revenge (choosing to suffer like Christ).
- Forgiveness is the key to healing (for you, your family, your culture).
- Forgiveness is supernatural.
