**Gospel Conclusions** 

• Our love of each other says as much about God as it does about us. (v.7, 12)

• If you don't love, you don't know God.

- Love (Agape) starts with the Gospel. (v.5, 10)
  - o Our hearts are cold and desolate without Jesus.
    - God saw our great need.
    - God sent His only Son.
    - God settled our sin debt (propitiation).
    - God saved all who trust in Him!
- Love is expected from blessings. (v. 11)
- Love is transferred and perfected through relationships.
