It was one of “those days” . . .

- **Sometimes God’s plan leads to a storm.**
 - The disciples were eager to serve Jesus.
 - The disciples were capable of the job required.
 - They were doing the will of Jesus (God).
- **Sometimes it seems like God is asleep!**
 - The sea changed – from settled to a storm.
 - The men’s hearts changed – from settled to a storm.
 - Jesus . . . was asleep!
- **Sometimes God’s intervention is alarming.**
 - In all three accounts it notes He got up!
 - The storm stopped with a word.
 - Jesus spoke to the storm, then spoke to them.

- **Where is your faith?**

- Storms ≠ Punishment
- Silence ≠ Indifference
- Amazement ≠ Understanding

Your storm is part of a greater story that ends in glory.

3. What do you think God wanted readers to learn from this encounter in Luke 8?
