What then are we to say about these things?

- Believe God’s word and proclaim God’s word in any circumstance.

Forasmuch as God is for us, who is against us?

- No one can defeat God. So, abide in Him and you can’t lose.
- The One who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world. (1 John 4:4)
- God owns your timeline, and He is faithful when you are faithless. (2 Timothy 2:13)

From when we are first saved until our dying breath, Romans 8 brings us to a place of confidence.

- James 1:2-8 makes complete sense in light of Romans chapter 8.

This world, energized by Satan, wants to deconstruct a believer's faith amid trials.

Our love for Jesus cannot be contingent on our ease of life this side of Heaven.

Whatever trials you are facing, grab what God says and don't let go. It's a sword to overcome, moment by moment.
