Frequently asked questions about Austin Stone Jam Nights.

Do I have to join a Jam if I come?

Definitely not! You're welcome to just hang out and watch!

Are there any songs I need to learn before attending Jam Night?

Great question! We leave it open for spontaneous collaboration. We'll give each group a chance to have a quick 10-minute "rehearsal" in a separate room before jamming. This allows you to chat with your bandmates beforehand and decide what to play. It's fast, but we think it adds to the fun!

What should I bring? Can I bring my Marshall Half Stack?

You don't have to bring anything! However, players are encouraged to bring personal items, such as drumsticks, guitars (acoustic, electric, or bass), picks, and pedals. If you aren't able to bring them, no worries—we'll have some you can borrow!

You do NOT need to bring drums, cymbals, bass or guitar amps, keyboards, microphones, or DI boxes. The space we use provides the essential backline, along with all the mics and a sound system. They even offer an entire second backline for the rehearsal room.

How do I get in on the fun?

Just sign up! Upon arrival, we'll have a table where you can sign up for a time slot and indicate your preferred instrument. Once it's your turn, you and your band will go into the smaller "rehearsal" room to work out what you want to play. After that, you'll take the stage in the big room to jam!
