

Little Dragon - Belts, Stripes, and Testings

Belts:

Beginner: White, White/Orange, Orange, Orange/Yellow, Yellow

Intermediate: Yellow/Camo, Camo, Camo/Green, Green, Green/Purple, Purple, Purple/Blue, Blue

Stripes:

All Beginner Belts need to earn five stripes to be eligible to test to their next belt color.

- Stripe 1: Student will demonstrate all the basic movements that are found in their form.
- **Stripe 2:** Student will follow instructor through the **form** demonstrating either proper hand or foot techniques (determined by the instructor).
- Stripe 3: Student will perform their bully self-defense techniques.
- Stripe 4: Student will perform their stranger danger self-defense techniques.
- **Parent Stripe** this is the most important stripe! Students need to earn their new belt from their parents, not just by being able to do Taekwondo.
 - Students will practice their form two times and their self-defense combinations for five minutes a night at home for one week.
 - o Parents will choose a chore or behavior that the student must do/follow for that week.

All Intermediate Belts need to earn six stripes to be eligible to test to their next belt color.

- Stripe 1: Student will demonstrate all the basic movements that are found in their form.
- **Stripe 2:** Student will follow instructor through the **form** demonstrating either proper hand or foot techniques (determined by the instructor).
- Stripe 3: Student will perform their bully self-defense techniques.
- Stripe 4: Student will perform their stranger danger self-defense techniques.
- Stripe 5: Student will demonstrate sparring combinations chosen by the instructor.
- **Parent Stripe** this is the most important stripe! Students need to earn their new belt from their parents, not just by being able to do Taekwondo.
 - Students will practice their form two times and their self-defense combinations for five minutes a night at home for one week.
 - o Parents will choose a chore or behavior that the student must do/follow for that week.
