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**[draft] Order**

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**UPON** the Order of Mr Justice Kimblin dated 7 January 2026 in the claims brought by Wilson Solicitors LLP challenging the Defendant's policy titled "Nationality: good character requirement, Version 6.0" ("Good Character Policy v6"), varied by the Order of Mr Justice Kimblin dated 2 March 2026, granting permission to apply for judicial review on all grounds in claims 1516, 3713, 3714 and 4307

**AND UPON** paragraph 2 of the 7 January 2026 Order staying the claims specified in Part B of the Schedule to the Order [and the Orders dated XXX staying claims XXX] ("Stayed Wilson GC Claims")

**AND UPON** paragraph 3 of the same Order providing for a process for other individuals to extend the limitation period for judicial review claims challenging the Good Character Policy v6 and/or decisions taken under the policy until 3 months after the Administrative Court makes final orders in the Lead Claims ("Extended GC Claims")

**AND UPON** the Claimants having applied on 23 April 2026 for permission to amend their grounds to include a challenge to a document entitled “*Good Character: Illegal entry and dangerous journeys*”, disclosed to them on 26 March 2026.

**AND UPON** the Claimants becoming aware on 1 May 2026 that the Defendant had published new policy guidance dated 30 April 2026, “Nationality: good character requirement, Version 7” (“Good Character Policy v7”)

**AND UPON** the Defendant withdrawing the decisions to refuse British citizenship to the Claimants GUN, NEA, HCH and the Claimants in the Stayed Wilson GC Claims, including any decisions to refuse to reconsider refusal decisions, and agreeing to make new decisions on the Claimants’ entitlement to British citizenship, with these Claimants to have 28 days from the date this Order is sealed to submit representations addressing the Good Character Policy v7, together with any further evidence, and the Defendant to make new decisions based on the information and evidence before the Defendant at that time within 42 days thereafter, absent special circumstances

**AND UPON** the Defendant agreeing to review any decisions to refuse British citizenship in the Extended GC Claims, with all such individuals to have 56 days from the date this Order is sealed to submit representations addressing the Good Character Policy v7, together with any further evidence, with the Defendant to make new decisions on the information and evidence before the Defendant at that time within a reasonable period of time

**AND UPON** the Defendant agreeing to review and re-make any decision to refuse British citizenship due to illegal entry and/or a dangerous journey to the UK made between 10 February 2025 and 29 April 2026 applying the Good Character Policy v6 provided that any person who is the subject of such a decision makes a request within 56 days of the date this Order is sealed addressing the Good Character Policy v7

**AND UPON** the parties confirming that they will seek to agree separate Orders disposing of the Stayed Wilson GC Claims, with the Defendant agreeing to pay the Claimants’ reasonable costs of those claims, to be assessed on the standard basis if not agreed

**AND UPON** the Claimants agreeing to withdraw their claims and this being without prejudice to any future claim challenging Good Character Policy v7

**BY CONSENT, IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. Withdrawal: the Claimants have permission to withdraw their applications for judicial review, and the claims are hereby withdrawn.
  
2. Costs:
  - a. The Defendant shall pay the Claimants' reasonable costs of the claims, to be assessed on the standard basis if not agreed.
  - b. Within 28 days after service of the Claimants' bill of costs, the Defendant shall make a payment on account of at least 50% of the costs set out in the bill of costs.
  - c. There shall be a detailed assessment of the Claimants' publicly funded costs in accordance with the Civil Legal Aid (Costs) Regulations 2013 and CPR r.47.18.
