

# Transforming Climate Action Designated Spaces Initiative

## Fostering inclusion, support and belonging

We recognize that building a truly inclusive culture means not only acknowledging systemic barriers but actively working to create room for authentic expression and connection. The Designated Space Initiative is designed to create safer, affirming spaces for members of underrepresented groups within TCA to connect, share common experiences, and feel seen and supported.

## Designated spaces:

- Women
- Racialized individuals
- Black, African, and Caribbean communities
- Indigenous peoples
- 2SLGBTQIA+ communities
- People with (dis)abilities

## What to expect:

- These spaces are voluntary, confidential, and centered around care, belonging, and empowerment
- Gatherings are expected to occur three times per year as needed
- Participation in the spaces will help inform required changes in TCA
- Launch date: Fall 2025/Winter 2026 (with registration open on an ongoing basis)
