1. What details are given about the crowd and their actions when Jesus enters Jerusalem?

2. What kind of king do the crowds seem to expect, based on their actions and words?

3. Why does John emphasize that the disciples didn't fully understand these events at first?

4. In what ways are people today tempted to shape Jesus into the kind of king they want?

5. What does Jesus mean when He says, "The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified"?

6. What does Jesus mean by "loving" or "hating" one's life in **verses 25-26**?

7. What does it look like in everyday life to "die" like the grain of wheat Jesus describes?

8. Why do you think the crowd struggles to understand Jesus' teaching about the Son of Man?

9. How does this passage shape how you view Jesus—not just as Savior, but as King?
