Read John 18:1-27.

1. What does Jesus' decision to go to the garden, where Judas knew to find Him, reveal about His character?

2. Why is it significant that Jesus steps forward and asks, "Who are you looking for?" **Verse 18:4**

3. What is the meaning and importance of Jesus saying, "I am he", in this passage? **Verse 18:5-6**

4. How does Jesus demonstrate courage differently than how we typically think about courage?

5. What does Jesus protecting the disciples by saying, "let these men go", **verse 18:8-9**, show us about His leadership and love?

6. Why does Jesus stop Peter from fighting, and what does that teach us about God's plan?

7. How do Jesus and Peter respond differently under pressure in this passage?

8. In what ways do we still deny Jesus today, even if we do not say it out loud?

9. Why is it important that Peter denies Jesus three times, just as Jesus predicted?

10. What is the main message of the gospel seen in this story, especially in the contrast between Jesus' faithfulness and Peter's failure?
