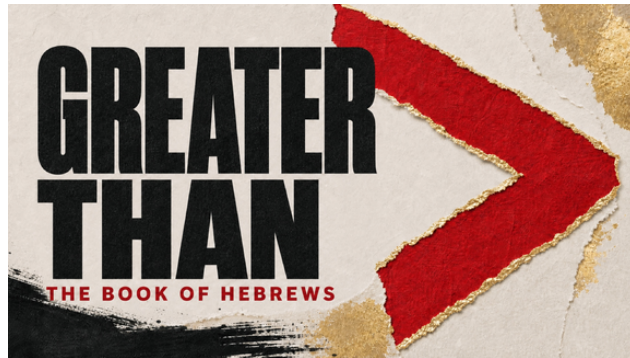


Jesus Is Greater Than.

3. Have you ever had the thought "If only God would communicate by _____ then more people would listen?" How would you fill in the blank? According to this passage is that true? (**Luke 16:27-31** also sheds light on this.)

4. God has chosen to communicate throughout history. What impact does it make on you to understand that God desires to communicate with you personally?

5. How do we know that the final means of communicating is through Jesus?

6. What is the job description of Jesus according to these verses? Take time to ponder each of those statements about Jesus. How does Hebrews show that Jesus was more than a moral teacher or a good example? How can we make sure we turn factual statements about Jesus into opportunities to worship?

7. What is the significance of the word of Jesus according to **verse 3**? How does that help when it seems like everything is falling apart?

8. What is the significance of saying that Jesus is superior even to angels?

9. Does your view of the world tend to distract from what Hebrews is saying or does your view of what the Bible says give you confidence while living in this broken world?

10. The major theme we will be seeing throughout Hebrews is "Jesus is Greater". What are some areas of your life where it would be especially helpful to remember that Jesus is greater?
