## SERVING IN HUMILITY AND LOVE

### Serving Like Jesus: The Example We Follow

Even as Jesus prepares to face betrayal and suffering, He reassures His disciples of their identity, those who belong to Him. He knows the storm is coming, and yet He provides hope that transcends circumstances. 'You will be with me,' He promises, instilling a sense of confidence about their future.
