JESUS PRAYS | John 17:1-26

## UNIFYING FOR HIS GLORY

### **The Glory of Christ: Our Privilege and Prayer**

In John 17:1-5, Jesus lifts His eyes to heaven and prays for His own glorification, showcasing an essential aspect of His mission. He wants us to understand that His glory is intrinsically linked with the Father's glory. This mutual glorification isn't just a theological concept; it's an invitation for us to partake in His divine purposes. Christ's prayer reminds us that our lives should reflect His glory and, in turn, glorify God. As Jesus transitions into prayer for future believers, He states in John 17:20-23 that we will do greater works than He did. This seems daunting, but it speaks to the multiplying effect of His ministry through us. The Holy Spirit equips us, allowing an ordinary person to accomplish extraordinary things for the Kingdom. We are not meant to hunker down in isolation; rather, we are tasked with spreading hope and light in our communities. Embracing this mission means that we must step out with confidence, trusting that the same power that raised Christ from the dead is at work within us.

### **The Power of Unity: Witness to the World**

Jesus' fervent prayer for our unity reveals how significant it is for our witness in John 17:24-26. Unity among believers isn't merely a lack of conflict; it's a profound shared life in Christ that reflects the relationship between Him and the Father. When we live in unity, we exhibit the love and truth of Christ to a watching world that is deeply fractured. This oneness can draw others to Him, showing that though we are different, our hearts are aligned with the purpose to honor God. Striving for unity should drive our conversations, actions, and interactions, leading to deeper connections within our community.
