- More stable handling of signal loss alarms and digital I/O display.
- SmartSSD updater tuned to run only when needed.
- Email handling streamlined to reduce unnecessary error logs.

- Improved responsiveness when editing server information.
- Pop-up and closing behavior refined for a smoother workflow.
- Better access to new Archive Server database fields.
