


Tailor-Made Itinerary – Florian

This program is crafted for a solo traveler seeking luxury and authenticity, with a preferred departure in November 2025 and a budget of 3000 euros. The itinerary below is crafted with expert logistics and luxury standards, fully customizable to your needs.

* Why Argentina?

Argentina is a dream destination for solo travelers who crave both adventure and comfort. November is springtime in Argentina, offering mild weather and blooming landscapes—ideal for exploring Patagonia's glaciers, the wine country of Mendoza, or the cosmopolitan energy of Buenos Aires. The country's excellent infrastructure makes solo travel seamless, while its luxury hotels and world-class gastronomy ensure a refined experience. Whether you seek urban culture or breathtaking nature, Argentina is perfectly suited to your preferences.

* Custom Program

Note: The following program assumes a 10-day trip, which is typical for a

first discovery of Argentina with a focus on luxury and highlights. Dates and duration can be adjusted as needed.

Day 1: Arrival in Buenos Aires

- Morning: International arrival at Ezeiza Airport. Private transfer (45 min) to your luxury hotel in Recoleta or Palermo. Early check-in subject to availability.
- Afternoon: Rest and settle in. Option for a private guided walk through the leafy streets of Recoleta, visiting the famous cemetery and elegant cafés.
- Evening: Gourmet welcome dinner at a top Buenos Aires restaurant,
 with wine pairing.
- Highlight: Personalized welcome and first taste of Argentine hospitality.

Hotel options:

- Alvear Palace Hotel (Luxury, Recoleta): Belle Époque grandeur,
 impeccable service, and a rooftop spa. From €350/night.
- Palacio Duhau Park Hyatt (Luxury, Recoleta): Elegant palace meets modern luxury, lush gardens and fine dining. From €400/night.
- Legado Mitico (Boutique, Palermo Soho): Stylish, intimate,
 themed rooms inspired by Argentine icons. From €220/night.
- Activity: Private guided walk in Recoleta: Discover the iconic

cemetery, Belle Époque architecture, and local cafés with a knowledgeable guide.

TIP: Buenos Aires is cosmopolitan, but pickpocketing can occur in busy areas—keep valuables secure.

ී Day 2: Buenos Aires - City & Tango

- Morning: Private city tour with an English-speaking guide: Plaza de Mayo, San Telmo, La Boca, and Puerto Madero. Private vehicle (4h).
- Afternoon: Leisure time for art galleries or shopping. Optional visit to MALBA (Latin American Art Museum).
- Evening: VIP tango show and dinner at a renowned venue, with backstage access.
- **Highlight:** Immersive tango experience in true Buenos Aires style.
- Same hotel options as Day 1.
- Activity: Tango show at Rojo Tango (Faena Hotel): Intimate, glamorous performance with gourmet dinner and backstage meet-and-greet.

TIP: Dress smart-casual for tango venues; some have a formal dress code.

Solution Day 3: Buenos Aires to El Calafate (Patagonia)

- Morning: Private transfer to airport (45 min). Direct flight to El
 Calafate (3h).
- Afternoon: Arrival and private transfer (40 min) to a luxury lodge

- overlooking Lago Argentino.
- Evening: Relax at the hotel spa or enjoy Patagonian cuisine with lake views.
- **Highlight:** First glimpse of Patagonia's wild landscapes in comfort.
- Hotel options:
 - Eolo Patagonia Spirit (Luxury, countryside): Remote, serene,
 panoramic views, gourmet cuisine. From €600/night.
 - Los Ponchos Boutique Hotel (Boutique, lakeside): Artistic design, warm hospitality, lake and mountain views. From €250/night.
 - Estancia Cristina (Eco-lodge, remote): Historic ranch, exclusive excursions, glacier access. From €400/night.
- Activity: Spa session at Eolo: Unwind with Patagonian-inspired treatments and panoramic views of the steppe.

TIP: Weather in Patagonia is unpredictable—pack layers and windproof clothing.

9 Day 4: Perito Moreno Glacier

- Morning: Private excursion (4×4, 1.5h each way) to Perito Moreno
 Glacier. Guided walk along panoramic balconies.
- Afternoon: Optional mini-trekking on the glacier (with specialist guides; moderate fitness required), or boat navigation close to the ice wall.

- **Evening:** Return to lodge. Optional Patagonian lamb dinner.
- Highlight: Awe-inspiring glacier experience, tailored for solo travelers.
- Same hotel options as Day 3.
- Activity: Mini-trekking on Perito Moreno Glacier: Walk on ancient ice
 with expert guides, marvel at crevasses and blue caves.

TIP: Glacier excursions require sturdy shoes and sunglasses; bring cash for park entry fees.

್ರಿ Day 5: El Calafate to Buenos Aires

- Morning: Leisure at the lodge or optional visit to a Patagonian
 estancia (ranch) for a taste of rural life. Private transfer (30–60 min).
- Afternoon: Private transfer to airport (40 min). Flight to Buenos Aires
 (3h).
- Evening: Check into luxury hotel. Evening at leisure or rooftop cocktail with city views.
- Highlight: Contrasts between wild Patagonia and urban sophistication.
- Same hotel options as Day 1.
- Activity: Visit to Estancia Nibepo Aike: Authentic ranch experience,
 horseback riding, and traditional barbecue lunch.

TIP: Domestic flights in Argentina allow 15–23 kg checked luggage; excess

charges apply for overweight bags.

Day 6: Buenos Aires to Mendoza (Wine Country)

- Morning: Private transfer to airport (45 min). Flight to Mendoza (2h).
- Afternoon: Arrival and private transfer (30–60 min) to a luxury wine lodge in the vineyards.
- **Evening:** Wine tasting and gourmet dinner at the lodge.
- Highlight: Sunset over the Andes with a glass of Malbec.
- Hotel options:
 - Cavas Wine Lodge (Luxury, Luján de Cuyo): Vineyard suites,
 private plunge pools, spa, and gourmet dining. From €650/night.
 - The Vines Resort & Spa (Luxury, Uco Valley): Modern villas,
 mountain views, Francis Mallman restaurant. From €600/night.
 - Casa de Uco (Eco-lodge, Uco Valley): Sleek design, organic wines, adventure activities. From €350/night.
- Activity: Wine tasting at Cavas Wine Lodge: Sample top Malbecs with a sommelier, overlooking the Andes at sunset.

TIP: Mendoza sits at 750–1,100 m altitude; stay hydrated and pace wine tastings.

Day 7: Mendoza – Vineyards & Gastronomy

 Morning: Private tour (car, 6–8h) of top wineries in Luján de Cuyo or Uco Valley, with tastings and cellar visits.

- Afternoon: Gourmet lunch at a vineyard restaurant. Leisure time for spa or cycling in the vines.
- Evening: Optional cooking class or evening at leisure.
- Highlight: Exclusive access to Argentina's finest wines and chefs.
- Same hotel options as Day 6.
- Activity: Cooking class at The Vines Resort: Prepare regional dishes with a chef, paired with local wines.

TIP: Book winery visits in advance; top estates have limited daily slots.

್ರಿ Day 8: Mendoza to Buenos Aires

- Morning: Relax at the lodge or optional hot air balloon ride (weather permitting; 1h).
- **Afternoon:** Private transfer to airport (30–60 min). Flight to Buenos Aires (2h).
- Evening: Final night in a luxury hotel. Optional evening stroll in Puerto
 Madero or Palermo Soho.
- **Highlight:** Reflective solo moments in the city lights.
- Same hotel options as Day 1.
- Activity: Hot air balloon ride over vineyards: Soar above the Andes foothills at sunrise for breathtaking views.

TIP: Balloon rides are weather-dependent; have a backup activity planned.

ී Day 9: Buenos Aires – Art & Leisure

- Morning: Private guided tour focused on art, architecture, or literature, according to your interests.
- Afternoon: Free time for shopping, museums, or a spa session.
- **Evening:** Farewell dinner at a chef's table or speakeasy.
- Highlight: Personalized cultural immersion to end your journey.
- Same hotel options as Day 1.
- Activity: Private art tour: Visit hidden galleries and artist studios in Palermo or San Telmo with a local expert.

TIP: Book chef's table experiences early; top venues fill up weeks in advance.

್ರಿ Day 10: Departure

- Morning: Private transfer (45 min) to Ezeiza Airport for your international flight.
- Afternoon/Evening: End of services.
- **Highlight:** Smooth, stress-free departure.

TIP: Allow at least 3h for international check-in at Ezeiza Airport.
