Custom Program



Day 1: Arrival in Arusha – Gateway to Adventure

- **Morning:** Arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport. Private transfer (~1h) to your luxury lodge in Arusha. Time to settle in and recover from your journey.
- **Afternoon:** Relax at the lodge, enjoy the pool or spa, or take a gentle guided walk in the lush gardens.
- **Evening:** Gourmet dinner at the lodge's restaurant, with views of Mount Meru.
- **Highlight:** Welcome briefing with your dedicated driver-guide to discuss the adventure ahead.
- **Hotel options:**
 - **Legendary Lodge** (luxury, outskirts of Arusha): Colonial-style cottages set in lush gardens, renowned for personalized service and gourmet cuisine; from €600/night.
 - **Arusha Coffee Lodge** (boutique, Shamba Estate): Stylish plantation suites nestled among coffee fields, with spa and pool; from €350/night.
 - **Gran Melia Arusha** (luxury resort, central Arusha): Contemporary rooms, panoramic views, and extensive amenities; from €250/night.

- **Activity:** Guided garden walk at Legendary Lodge: discover indigenous plants and birdlife in a tranquil setting.

TIP: If arriving early, request an early check-in or book a day room to refresh before your adventure begins.

Day 2: Tarangire National Park – Land of Giants

- **Morning:** Early departure. Private transfer (~2h30) to Tarangire National Park, famous for its elephant herds and baobab trees. Game drive en route to your lodge.
- **Afternoon:** Lunch at the lodge, followed by a guided game drive in the park.
- **Evening:** Sundowner drinks overlooking the Tarangire River, followed by a gourmet dinner.
- **Highlight:** Spotting elephants and iconic baobabs in golden afternoon light.
- **Hotel options:**
 - **Sanctuary Swala Camp** (luxury tented camp, remote southern Tarangire): Elegant tents with private decks, exceptional wildlife viewing; from €700/night.
 - **Tarangire Treetops** (boutique lodge, park boundary): Elevated treehouse suites with panoramic views and adventurous design; from €600/night.
 - **Oliver's Camp** (eco-lodge, central Tarangire): Classic safari

ambiance, guided walks and night drives; from €400/night.

- **Activity:** Guided afternoon game drive: track elephants, lions, and rare antelope with an expert ranger.

TIP: Tarangire is best known for elephants and baobabs—bring binoculars for birdwatching, as over 500 species are recorded here.

Day 3: Tarangire to Lake Manyara – Rift Valley Views

- **Morning:** Short morning game drive in Tarangire. Private transfer (~2h) to Lake Manyara area, nestled at the base of the Rift Valley escarpment.
- **Afternoon:** Explore Lake Manyara National Park: tree-climbing lions, flamingos, and hippos. Picnic lunch in the park.
- **Evening:** Settle into your luxury lodge with panoramic views. Optional spa treatment or cultural visit to a local village.
- **Highlight:** Sunset over the Rift Valley from your lodge terrace.
- **Hotel options:**
 - **Lake Manyara Kilimamoja Lodge** (luxury, escarpment): Spacious suites with private balconies, infinity pool, and sweeping valley views; from €400/night.
 - **Escarpment Luxury Lodge** (boutique, lake overlook): Contemporary design, tranquil gardens, and excellent cuisine; from €350/night.
 - **Gibb's Farm** (eco-lodge, Karatu): Historic farmhouse with

organic gardens, immersive cultural experiences; from €500/night.

- **Activity:** Lake Manyara game drive: spot flamingos and tree-climbing lions in a lush groundwater forest.

TIP: Lake Manyara's terrain is varied—expect forest, grassland, and lakeshore. Spa treatments and massages are available at most lodges for relaxation.

Day 4: Ngorongoro Crater – Wildlife Eden

- **Morning:** Early transfer (~1h30) to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Descend into the Crater for a full-day game drive—home to lions, rhinos, and abundant wildlife.
- **Afternoon:** Picnic lunch on the Crater floor. Continue exploring, then ascend to your lodge perched on the rim.
- **Evening:** Relax by the fireplace with a glass of wine and crater views.
- **Highlight:** Witnessing the dense concentration of animals in the world's largest intact caldera.
- **Hotel options:**
 - **Ngorongoro Crater Lodge** (luxury, crater rim): Opulent suites with dramatic views, butler service, and gourmet dining; from €1200/night.
 - **The Highlands** (eco-lodge, forested slopes): Futuristic domes, immersive Maasai experiences, and privacy; from €800/night.

- **Neptune Ngorongoro Lodge** (boutique, lush gardens): Spacious cottages, wellness spa, and organic cuisine; from €500/night.
- **Activity:** Full-day crater safari: spot endangered black rhino, lions, and herds of wildebeest in a UNESCO World Heritage landscape.

ALTITUDE: The crater rim is above 2,200m; the floor is ~1,800m. Mild altitude effects possible—stay hydrated and avoid strenuous activity on arrival.

Day 5: Serengeti Bound – Endless Plains

- **Morning:** Transfer to Serengeti National Park via scenic drive (~3h) or optional small aircraft flight (~1h, supplement applies). Game drive en route to your camp.
- **Afternoon:** Settle into your luxury tented camp, then head out for an afternoon safari.
- **Evening:** Fireside dinner under the stars, with Maasai storytelling or traditional music.
- **Highlight:** First encounter with the Serengeti's vast herds and predators.
- **Hotel options:**
 - **Four Seasons Safari Lodge Serengeti** (luxury, central Serengeti): Elegant suites, infinity pool overlooking a waterhole, family-friendly amenities; from €900/night.
 - **Singita Sabora Tented Camp** (boutique, Grumeti Reserve):

Vintage safari style, private decks, and immersive wildlife viewing; from €1200/night.

- **Kubu Kubu Tented Lodge** (eco-lodge, central Serengeti):
Spacious tents, panoramic views, and excellent guiding; from €500/night.

- **Activity:** Maasai storytelling evening: gather around the campfire to hear traditional tales and songs from local Maasai hosts.

TIP: If flying, luggage is limited to 15kg per person in soft bags. The road transfer offers scenic stops—ask your guide for a picnic en route.

Day 6: Serengeti – Big Five Safari

- **Morning:** Sunrise game drive—prime time for predator sightings.
Bush breakfast in the wild.
- **Afternoon:** Leisure at camp or pool, then another game drive focusing on migration routes (seasonal).
- **Evening:** Private dinner on your tent veranda or communal dining with other travelers.
- **Highlight:** Watching lions or cheetahs on the hunt.
- **Hotel options:**
 - Same hotel options as Day 5.
- **Activity:** Balloon safari (optional, advance booking): soar above the Serengeti at sunrise for breathtaking aerial views and a champagne breakfast.

TIP: The Great Migration peaks June–October in the north and December–March in the south—ask your guide about current wildlife movements.

Day 7: Serengeti to Arusha – Farewell to the Wild

- **Morning:** Final game drive or optional bush breakfast. Transfer to Serengeti airstrip for flight (~1h) to Arusha (included in most luxury packages; luggage limits apply).
- **Afternoon:** Arrival in Arusha; day room at a boutique lodge for freshening up. Last-minute shopping or visit to a local coffee plantation.
- **Evening:** Private transfer (~1h) to Kilimanjaro Airport for your international departure.
- **Highlight:** Reflecting on your safari adventure with a final view of Mount Meru.
- **Hotel options:**
 - **Arusha Coffee Lodge** (boutique, Shamba Estate): Day room in a tranquil plantation setting; from €150.
 - **Gran Melia Arusha** (luxury, central Arusha): Day room with spa access and late check-out; from €200.
 - **Kibo Palace Hotel** (boutique, city center): Comfortable rooms, pool, and easy airport access; from €100.
- **Activity:** Coffee plantation tour at Arusha Coffee Lodge: learn about

Tanzania's coffee heritage and sample fresh brews.

TIP: Plan for a late afternoon or evening international flight to allow time for your domestic connection and day room relaxation.

Customizable Options

- Private hot air balloon safari over the Serengeti (supplement applies; early booking essential).
- Exclusive bush dinner or sundowner setup in the wilderness.
- Family-friendly cultural visits (Maasai village, local school, or market).
- Wellness day: spa treatments and yoga at select luxury lodges.
- Photographic safari with a specialist guide and equipment (advance notice required).
- Extension to Zanzibar for a beach finale (flight from Arusha, 2–4 nights recommended).

Practical Info & Budget

- **Comfort level:** Luxury lodges and tented camps throughout, with private driver-guide as requested.
- **Indicative budget:** €4000 per person covers most luxury accommodations, private transport, park fees, and guided activities for 7–8 days. Excludes international flights, premium upgrades (balloon, spa), and Zanzibar extension.

- **Included:** Luxury lodging, private driver-guide, park fees, most meals, domestic flights (where noted), airport transfers.
- **Excluded:** International flights, visas, tips, personal expenses, insurance, optional upgrades.
- **Seasonal notes:** Best wildlife viewing is June–October (dry season). November–March offers lush scenery and fewer crowds, but some rain is possible. April–May is peak rainy season—some camps close or have limited access.
- **Luggage tips:** Soft bags preferred, especially for domestic flights (max 15kg per person if flying).
- **Budget check:** For full luxury and private guiding, €4000pp is at the lower end—consider reducing trip length, mixing in boutique options, or increasing budget for more upgrades.
- **To finalize:** Exact dates, trip duration, and any special requests (diet, mobility, celebration).
