


Tailor-Made Itinerary – Florian

The program below is designed for a 7-day journey, balancing comfort, adventure, and seamless logistics.

* Why Latin America?

Luxury small-group journeys foster connection and exclusivity, while boutique lodges and eco-resorts provide comfort and authenticity. The dry season (May–October) is optimal for most destinations.

* Custom Program

್ರಿ Day 1: Arrival in Lima, Peru

- Morning: Arrival at Jorge Chávez International Airport. Private transfer (45 min) to your hotel in Miraflores or Barranco.
- Afternoon: Settle in and enjoy a guided walk through the bohemian
 Barranco district, known for its art galleries and ocean views.
- Evening: Welcome dinner at a top Peruvian restaurant, sampling ceviche and pisco cocktails.

Hotel options:

- Hotel B (Boutique, Barranco): Chic art-filled mansion, from
 €350/night.
- Belmond Miraflores Park (Luxury, Miraflores): Rooftop pool,
 ocean views, from €400/night.
- Atemporal (Boutique, Miraflores): Intimate townhouse,
 personalized service, from €250/night.
- Activity: Barranco Art Walk Explore Lima's creative heart with a local guide.

TIP: Lima's culinary scene is world-class; consider booking a tasting menu at Central or Maido in advance.

್ರಿ Day 2: Sacred Valley of the Incas

 Morning: Flight to Cusco (1h 20m). Private transfer (1h 30m) to the Sacred Valley for acclimatization.

- Afternoon: Visit the Pisac ruins and market, then relax at your luxury lodge.
- Evening: Farm-to-table dinner with Andean ingredients.

Hotel options:

- Inkaterra Hacienda Urubamba (Luxury eco-lodge, Sacred
 Valley): Panoramic valley views, from €400/night.
- Sol y Luna (Boutique, Urubamba): Artistic casitas, spa, from
 €350/night.
- Explora Sacred Valley (Luxury adventure lodge, Urquillos):
 Guided excursions, all-inclusive, from €500/night.
- Activity: Pisac Market Visit Discover traditional crafts and local produce.

ALTITUDE: The Sacred Valley is at ~2,800 m. Hydrate, rest, and avoid heavy meals on arrival.

TIP: Sacred Valley is ideal for acclimatization before heading to higher altitudes in Cusco or Machu Picchu.

💖 Day 3: Ollantaytambo & Train to Machu Picchu

- Morning: Private transfer (40 min) to Ollantaytambo. Guided tour of the Inca fortress.
- Afternoon: Vistadome train (1h 30m) to Aguas Calientes, gateway to Machu Picchu.
- Evening: Relax at your hotel, soak in thermal baths, or stroll the

riverside.

Hotel options:

- Inkaterra Machu Picchu Pueblo Hotel (Eco-lodge, Aguas
 Calientes): Lush gardens, nature trails, from €400/night.
- Sumaq Machu Picchu Hotel (Luxury, Aguas Calientes): Gourmet
 Peruvian cuisine, from €350/night.
- El Mapi by Inkaterra (Boutique, central): Modern comfort, from
 €220/night.
- Activity: Ollantaytambo Fortress Tour Marvel at ancient terraces and ceremonial sites.

ALTITUDE: Aguas Calientes is at ~2,000 m; altitude effects are mild but acclimatization continues.

TIP: Book train tickets and Machu Picchu entry well in advance, especially in high season.

ಲೆ Day 4: Machu Picchu & Return to Cusco

- Morning: Early shuttle (30 min) to Machu Picchu. Guided tour of the citadel, with optional hike to Sun Gate.
- Afternoon: Vistadome train (3h 30m) to Cusco. Private transfer (20 min) to your hotel.
- Evening: Dinner in Cusco's historic center.
- Hotel options:
 - o Belmond Palacio Nazarenas (Luxury, Historic Center): Colonial

- architecture, spa, from €500/night.
- Inkaterra La Casona (Boutique, Plaza de Armas): Intimate suites, heritage charm, from €400/night.
- Palacio del Inka (Luxury, city center): Historic ambiance, from €350/night.
- Activity: Machu Picchu Guided Tour Explore the mysteries of the Lost City of the Incas.

ALTITUDE: Cusco is at ~3,400 m. Walk slowly, hydrate, and avoid strenuous activity on arrival.

TIP: Consider a private guide for deeper insight into Machu Picchu's history and architecture.

ಲಿ Day 5: Cusco City & San Blas

- Morning: Walking tour of Cusco's UNESCO-listed center: Koricancha,
 Cathedral, and San Blas artisan quarter.
- Afternoon: Optional cooking class or chocolate workshop.
- Evening: Dinner at a fusion restaurant in San Blas.
- **Hotel options:** Same hotel options as Day 4.
- Activity: San Blas Artisans Meet local artists and discover Andean crafts.

ALTITUDE: Continue to monitor for altitude symptoms; coca tea is a local remedy.

TIP: San Blas is hilly; wear comfortable shoes and take breaks as needed.

2 Day 6: Flight to Buenos Aires, Argentina

- Morning: Private transfer (20 min) to Cusco airport. Flight to Buenos
 Aires (via Lima; total flight time ~6h).
- Afternoon: Private transfer (45 min) to your hotel in Recoleta or Palermo.
- **Evening:** Tango show and dinner at an iconic Buenos Aires venue.
- Hotel options:
 - Alvear Palace Hotel (Luxury, Recoleta): Belle Époque elegance,
 from €500/night.
 - Palermo Place (Boutique, Palermo): Modern suites, lively neighborhood, from €220/night.
 - Legado Mitico (Boutique, Palermo Soho): Themed rooms,
 literary vibe, from €250/night.
- Activity: Tango Experience Enjoy Argentina's iconic dance in a historic setting.

TIP: Buenos Aires is cosmopolitan and safe; explore on foot and try local empanadas.

Day 7: Buenos Aires City & Departure

 Morning: Guided city tour: Plaza de Mayo, San Telmo, La Boca's colorful streets.

- Afternoon: Optional visit to MALBA (Latin American Art Museum) or shopping in Palermo Soho.
- Evening: Private transfer (45 min) to Ezeiza International Airport for departure.
- Hotel options: Same hotel options as Day 6 (day-use available).
- Activity: La Boca Walking Tour Discover the birthplace of tango and local street art.

TIP: Arrange late check-out or day-use room if your flight departs in the evening.

* Customizable Options

- Upgrade to a suite or private villa at select lodges (subject to availability).
- Add a guided hike to Rainbow Mountain near Cusco (from €120 extra).
- Participate in a private wine tasting in Mendoza (extension available).
- Extend with an extra night in Patagonia for glacier trekking or horseback riding.
- Request a specialist guide for photography or birdwatching (supplement applies).
- Arrange airport pickup or drop-off tailored to your flight schedule.

* Practical Info & Budget

- **Comfort:** Luxury and boutique hotels, prioritizing exclusivity, local character, and high-end service.
- Indicative budget: For a 7-day luxury small-group journey, expect
 €4,800–€7,000 per person including private transfers, internal flights, top guides, park fees, and premium accommodation (most meals included). International flights, drinks, tips, and optional activities are extra.
- Budget note: Traveling in shoulder season or choosing boutique hotels can optimize value. Private extensions or upgrades will increase the budget.
- Seasonal notes: May-October is best for Peru and Argentina.
 November-March is ideal for Patagonia and southern Chile.
- Luggage: Soft bags preferred for transfers and small aircraft; pack layers for variable climates.
- Included: Private transfers, luxury accommodation, expert guiding, park entry, most meals, internal flights.
- Excluded: International flights, visas, tips, drinks, personal expenses, some optional activities.
