The indicative budget is €1800 per person. This itinerary is auto-generated based on local expert experience, balancing romance, music heritage, and immersive nature.



Why Jamaica?

Jamaica is a vibrant blend of lush rainforests, white-sand beaches, and a culture pulsing with music and warmth—perfect for a honeymoon.

February is one of the best months to visit: it's the dry season, with pleasant temperatures and minimal rain, ideal for exploring both coast and mountains. With a driver-guide, you'll experience authentic local life, from Bob Marley's legacy to hidden waterfalls, while enjoying diverse, stylish stays. Jamaica's size allows for a rich, yet relaxed circuit without excessive transfers.



Custom Program

Day 1: Arrival in Montego Bay

- **Morning:** Arrive at Montego Bay airport; meet your driver-guide.
Private transfer: 20 min to hotel.
- **Afternoon:** Settle in, relax by the pool or beach. Short orientation stroll in the Hip Strip area.
- **Evening:** Romantic dinner with a sea view; sample fresh seafood and Jamaican rum cocktails.
- **Highlight:** Sunset over Doctor's Cave Beach.
- **Hotel options:**
 - **S Hotel** (Boutique, Hip Strip): Chic, contemporary design with direct beach access; from €250/night.
 - **Half Moon** (Luxury, Rose Hall): Iconic beachfront resort with lush gardens and spa; from €400/night.
 - **Round Hill Villas** (Eco-lodge, Hopewell): Historic plantation vibe, private villas, renowned service; from €350/night.
- **Activity:** Orientation stroll along the Hip Strip—vibrant shops, local art, and music bars.

TIP: Early check-in is subject to flight time; request in advance for honeymooners.

Day 2: Montego Bay – Rose Hall & River Adventure

- **Morning:** Guided visit to Rose Hall Great House. Private transfer: 20

min.

- **Afternoon:** Bamboo rafting on Martha Brae River. Private transfer: 30 min.
- **Evening:** Dinner at a local jerk restaurant; live reggae band if available.
- **Highlight:** Private bamboo raft experience, perfect for couples.
- **Hotel options:** Same hotel options as Day 1.
- **Activity:** Rose Hall Great House tour—explore haunted legends and colonial architecture.

TIP: Book rafting early for privacy; night tour at Rose Hall adds a romantic thrill.

Day 3: Montego Bay to Negril – Seven Mile Beach

- **Morning:** Scenic drive to Negril. Private transfer: 1.5h.
- **Afternoon:** Relax on Seven Mile Beach; optional glass-bottom boat ride or snorkeling.
- **Evening:** Sunset at Rick's Café; watch cliff divers with a cocktail.
- **Highlight:** Iconic Negril sunset, a honeymoon classic.
- **Hotel options:**
 - **The Spa Retreat** (Boutique, West End): Intimate stone cottages, oceanfront spa; from €250/night.
 - **The Caves** (Luxury, West End): Dramatic cliffside suites, candlelit grottos; from €400/night.

- **Tensing Pen** (Eco-lodge, West End): Rustic-chic cottages, tranquil gardens; from €300/night.
- **Activity:** Glass-bottom boat ride—spot tropical fish and coral reefs together.

TIP: Reserve a private cabana for sunset or arrange a beachside dinner.

Day 4: Negril – Nature & Wellness

- **Morning:** Couples' spa treatment or yoga session overlooking the sea.
- **Afternoon:** Visit to Mayfield Falls. Private transfer: 1h.
- **Evening:** Dinner at hotel; optional night beach walk.
- **Highlight:** Private waterfall swim, surrounded by tropical forest.
- **Hotel options:** Same hotel options as Day 3.
- **Activity:** Mayfield Falls—guided walk, swim in natural pools, and waterfall massage.

TIP: Bring water shoes for Mayfield Falls; surfaces can be slippery.

Day 5: Negril to Treasure Beach – South Coast Discovery

- **Morning:** Drive to Treasure Beach. Private transfer: 2.5h via scenic coastal route.
- **Afternoon:** Check-in and explore quiet fishing villages; optional cycling or local art tour.
- **Evening:** Farm-to-table dinner at a local eco-lodge.

- **Highlight:** Immersive local culture, away from crowds.
- **Hotel options:**
 - **Jakes Hotel** (Eco-lodge, Treasure Beach): Colorful cottages, artistic vibe, sea views; from €200/night.
 - **Lashings Villas** (Boutique, Treasure Beach): Contemporary design, rooftop bar, creative energy; from €180/night.
 - **Villa rental** (Luxury, Treasure Beach): Private pool, oceanfront, personalized service; from €400/night.
- **Activity:** Guided cycling tour—meet local artists and fishermen, discover hidden murals.

TIP: Cash is preferred in small villages; ATMs are limited.

Day 6: Treasure Beach – Black River & Pelican Bar

- **Morning:** Boat safari on Black River. Private transfer: 30 min.
- **Afternoon:** Boat ride to Pelican Bar, a rustic bar on a sandbar in the sea; swim and relax.
- **Evening:** Seafood BBQ at the bar or back at your lodge.
- **Highlight:** Toasting your honeymoon on a bar in the middle of the Caribbean.
- **Hotel options:** Same hotel options as Day 5.
- **Activity:** Black River safari—spot crocodiles, herons, and rare birds with a local guide.

TIP: Pelican Bar is rustic—bring sunscreen, hat, and cash for drinks.

Day 7: Treasure Beach – YS Falls & Rum Tasting

- **Morning:** Visit YS Falls. Private transfer: 1h.
- **Afternoon:** Appleton Estate rum distillery tour and tasting. Private transfer: 30 min.
- **Evening:** Relax at lodge, optional sunset yoga or beach bonfire.
- **Highlight:** Private rum tasting session.
- **Hotel options:** Same hotel options as Day 5.
- **Activity:** YS Falls—swim, zipline, and picnic in lush gardens.

TIP: Rum tastings can be strong—pace yourself and hydrate.

Day 8: Treasure Beach to Blue Mountains – Coffee Country

- **Morning:** Early scenic drive to Blue Mountains region. Private transfer: 4h with stops for photos and refreshments.
- **Afternoon:** Check-in at eco-lodge; guided walk in lush mountain forest.
- **Evening:** Dinner with mountain views; sample Blue Mountain coffee.
- **Highlight:** Immersive stay in Jamaica's highlands.
- **Hotel options:**
 - **Strawberry Hill** (Eco-lodge, Irish Town): Colonial charm, panoramic terraces, spa; from €350/night.
 - **Forres Park** (Boutique, Mavis Bank): Cozy rooms, coffee farm

setting, birdwatching; from €180/night.

- **Strawberry Hill suites** (Luxury, Irish Town): Private suites, exclusive amenities, mountain views; from €500/night.
- **Activity:** Guided forest walk—learn about endemic plants and birds.

ALTITUDE: The Blue Mountains rise above 2,000 m; acclimatize by staying hydrated and avoiding strenuous activity on arrival.

TIP: Nights are cooler—pack layers and a light jacket.

Day 9: Blue Mountains – Hiking & Coffee Experience

- **Morning:** Guided hike in Blue Mountains National Park; panoramic views and birdwatching.
- **Afternoon:** Private coffee plantation tour and tasting.
- **Evening:** Relax at lodge; stargazing or fireside drinks.
- **Highlight:** Learning about world-famous Blue Mountain coffee from local growers.
- **Hotel options:** Same hotel options as Day 8.
- **Activity:** Coffee plantation tour—meet growers, sample freshly roasted beans.

ALTITUDE: Take it slow on hikes; altitude may affect energy levels.

Day 10: Blue Mountains to Kingston – Bob Marley’s Legacy

- **Morning:** Drive to Kingston. Private transfer: 1.5h.
- **Afternoon:** Guided visit to Bob Marley Museum; explore Trench Town

and reggae history.

- **Evening:** Dinner at a Kingston jazz or reggae venue.
- **Highlight:** Immersive reggae experience in the capital.
- **Hotel options:**
 - **Spanish Court Hotel** (Boutique, New Kingston): Stylish, central, rooftop pool; from €200/night.
 - **Terra Nova All Suite** (Luxury, Waterloo): Elegant suites, gourmet dining, classic ambiance; from €300/night.
 - **Rafjam Blue Mountain** (Eco-lodge, Redlight District): Lush gardens, riverside cabins, tranquil escape; from €120/night.
- **Activity:** Bob Marley Museum VIP tour—exclusive memorabilia and private music session.

TIP: Kingston traffic can be heavy—plan transfers outside rush hours.

Day 11: Kingston – Art, Culture & Gardens

- **Morning:** Visit National Gallery of Jamaica and Devon House.
- **Afternoon:** Guided stroll in Hope Botanical Gardens or Emancipation Park.
- **Evening:** Gourmet dinner in New Kingston; optional rooftop cocktails.
- **Highlight:** Discovering Jamaica's creative scene.
- **Hotel options:** Same hotel options as Day 10.
- **Activity:** Devon House—historic mansion, artisan ice cream, and lush gardens.

TIP: Private art gallery tours can be arranged for deeper insight.

Day 12: Kingston to Port Antonio – Untamed East Coast

- **Morning:** Drive to Port Antonio. Private transfer: 3h with scenic stops.
- **Afternoon:** Check-in and relax at Frenchman's Cove or San San Beach.
- **Evening:** Dinner at eco-lodge or local seafood spot.
- **Highlight:** Secluded beach time in Jamaica's wildest region.
- **Hotel options:**
 - **Great Huts** (Eco-lodge, Boston Bay): African-inspired huts, clifftop views, cultural immersion; from €120/night.
 - **Geejam** (Boutique, San San): Music-themed suites, lush rainforest, private beach; from €350/night.
 - **Trident Hotel** (Luxury, Turtle Crawle Bay): Modern villas, infinity pool, exclusive privacy; from €600/night.
- **Activity:** Afternoon at Frenchman's Cove—swim in turquoise lagoon, picnic on the sand.

TIP: East Coast roads are winding—motion sickness remedies recommended.

Day 13: Port Antonio – Blue Lagoon & Rafting

- **Morning:** Private boat or kayak on the Blue Lagoon; swim in turquoise waters.

- **Afternoon:** Rafting on Rio Grande; picnic lunch on the riverbank.
- **Evening:** Dinner at hotel; optional live music night.
- **Highlight:** Romantic river journey through lush rainforest.
- **Hotel options:** Same hotel options as Day 12.
- **Activity:** Rio Grande rafting—traditional bamboo raft, local captain, riverside picnic.

TIP: Waterproof bags recommended for valuables during rafting.

Day 14: Port Antonio to Montego Bay – Departure

- **Morning:** Early drive back to Montego Bay. Private transfer: 4.5h with stops for breaks and lunch.
- **Afternoon:** Last swim or stroll if time allows; transfer to airport. Private transfer: 20 min.
- **Evening:** Departure flight.
- **Highlight:** Farewell to Jamaica's coastlines and music.
- **Hotel options:**
 - **Day room at airport hotel** (Montego Bay): Convenient, comfortable, ideal for late flights; from €100/night.

TIP: Confirm flight time for optimal transfer planning; allow extra time for airport security.

Customizable Options

- Private candlelit dinners on the beach or in the mountains.
- VIP reggae studio visit or private music session in Kingston.
- Helicopter scenic flight over Blue Mountains or North Coast.
- Wellness day: full spa immersion or yoga retreat.
- Cooking class with a local chef (Jamaican cuisine focus).
- Conservation or community visit (sea turtle project, local farm).

✦ Practical Info & Budget

- **Comfort:** Mix of luxury, boutique, and eco-lodge stays as requested.
- **Indicative budget:** €1800 per person for two weeks is tight for this comfort level, especially with a private driver-guide, premium hotels, and activities. Typical budget for such a trip is €2500–€3500 per person (excluding international flights). To fit €1800, consider reducing the trip to 8–10 days, opting for fewer luxury nights, or prioritizing eco-lodges.
- **Included:** Accommodation (double room), private driver-guide, main activities, breakfast, some dinners.
- **Excluded:** International flights, lunches, personal expenses, tips, optional upgrades.
- **Seasonal notes:** February is dry season—excellent for all regions. Nights can be cooler in the mountains; pack layers.
- **Luggage tips:** Light, casual clothing, swimwear, sun protection, and

one smart outfit for special dinners.

- **Gaps:** Exact travel dates, flight details, and final accommodation choices are TBD.

TIP: For a smoother experience, finalize preferred hotel choices and activity upgrades early.
