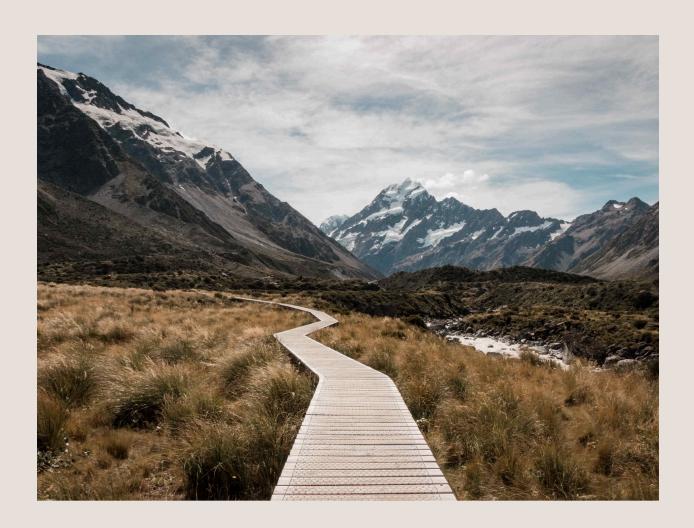


Tailor-Made Itinerary – Agilotext



* Portugal: Highlights & Hidden Gems – 10-Day Luxury Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Lisbon

- Private transfer from Lisbon Airport to hotel (approx. 30 min).
- Check-in and relax at your hotel.
- Optional: Evening stroll through Baixa-Chiado and welcome dinner at a local gourmet restaurant.

Hotel options:

- Tivoli Avenida Liberdade (Luxury) Central Lisbon; historic glamour,
 rooftop views, lush gardens. From €350/night.
- Valverde Hotel (Boutique) Avenida da Liberdade; intimate, art-filled, discreet luxury. From €320/night.
- Memmo Príncipe Real (Design/Boutique) Príncipe Real; modern chic, panoramic city views, infinity pool. From €270/night.

Activity: Lisbon Welcome Walk – Discover the vibrant neighborhoods of Baixa and Chiado with a private guide, introducing you to the city's history and culinary highlights.

TIP: Many Lisbon streets are cobbled and hilly; comfortable shoes recommended.

ಲೆ Day 2: Lisbon – Culture, Gastronomy & Fado

- Morning: Private walking & tasting tour of Lisbon's historic center
 (Alfama, Mouraria, Mercado da Ribeira).
- Afternoon: Free time for shopping or optional visit to the MAAT or Calouste Gulbenkian Museum.
- Evening: Fado dinner experience in Alfama with curated local cuisine and live music.

Same hotel options as Day 1.

Activity: Lisbon Food & Culture Tour – Savor local pastries, cheeses, and wines while exploring the city's most storied quarters.

TIP: Fado houses can be intimate; advance reservations are essential for the best tables.

9 Day 3: Sintra's Palaces & Coast

- Private transfer to Sintra (45 min).
- Guided tour: Pena Palace (early access), Quinta da Regaleira gardens, and Sintra village.
- Lunch with panoramic views.
- Afternoon: Optional detour to Cabo da Roca (westernmost point of Europe) and coastal drive via Cascais.
- Return to Lisbon (45 min).

Hotel options in Sintra (if you wish to overnight):

- Tivoli Palácio de Seteais (Luxury) Historic palace, elegant gardens,
 regal ambiance. From €400/night.
- Lawrence's Hotel (Boutique) Oldest hotel in the Iberian Peninsula,
 literary heritage, cozy charm. From €250/night.

Or: Same hotel options as Day 1 if returning to Lisbon.

Activity: Private Sintra Palace Tour – Early access to Pena Palace, avoiding crowds, and a guided walk through the mystical gardens of Quinta da Regaleira.

TIP: Sintra can be misty and cool, even in summer; bring a light jacket.

S Day 4: Lisbon to Alentejo (Évora & Countryside)

- Private transfer Lisbon to Évora (1h30).
- Guided exploration: Roman Temple, Évora Cathedral, Chapel of Bones.
- Lunch at a vineyard estate with olive oil and wine tasting.
- Afternoon: Relax at your countryside hotel or optional spa treatment.

Hotel options:

- Convento do Espinheiro (Luxury) 15th-century convent, lush grounds, spa. From €320/night.
- São Lourenço do Barrocal (Boutique/Wine Estate) Rustic luxury,
 vineyard setting, wellness focus. From €350/night.
- M'AR De AR Aqueduto (Boutique) Contemporary design in a historic building, central Évora. From €220/night.

Activity: Private Olive Oil & Wine Tasting – Sample regional products at a family-run estate, learning about Alentejo's culinary heritage.

TIP: Alentejo afternoons can be hot in summer; plan for a siesta or pool time.

Salentejo to Douro Valley (via Coimbra or Óbidos)

- Private transfer from Alentejo to Douro Valley (approx. 4h with scenic stops).
- Optional stop in Coimbra (university town, historic library) or Óbidos (medieval village).
- Arrive in Douro Valley, check-in and relax at your vineyard hotel.

LOGISTICS x: Direct transfer from Alentejo to Douro Valley is long (4h+).

Fix: Add a rest stop and lunch in Coimbra or Óbidos to break up the journey.

Hotel options:

- Six Senses Douro Valley (Luxury) Spa, panoramic river views,
 immersive wellness. From €600/night.
- Quinta da Pacheca (Wine Estate/Boutique) Stay in wine barrel suites, vineyard experiences. From €350/night.
- Quinta do Vallado (Boutique) Historic estate, modern design, renowned wines. From €250/night.

Activity: Scenic Douro Arrival – Enjoy a sunset drink overlooking the terraced vineyards and river.

TIP: The Douro's winding roads can cause motion sickness; request a comfortable vehicle and consider motion relief if sensitive.

ಲೆ Day 6: Douro Valley – Wine, River & Gastronomy

- Morning: Private wine estate visit (Quinta do Vallado or Quinta do Crasto) with tastings and vineyard tour.
- Lunch at a riverside estate.
- Afternoon: Private Douro river cruise with onboard wine and local delicacies.
- Evening: Relax at hotel or optional spa treatment.

Same hotel options as Day 5.

Activity: Douro River Cruise – Glide past UNESCO-listed vineyards on a private boat, sampling regional wines and tapas.

TIP: The Douro Valley is a UNESCO World Heritage site; photography opportunities abound—bring a camera or smartphone with plenty of storage.

9 Day 7: Douro Valley to Porto

- Private transfer to Porto (1h30).
- Guided walking tour of Porto's historic center: Clerigos Tower, Livraria
 Lello, São Bento Station, Ribeira district.
- Evening: Port wine tasting at Graham's or Taylor's cellars.

Hotel options:

- The Yeatman (Luxury) Gaia; panoramic city views, Michelin-star dining, extensive wine cellar. From €400/night.
- InterContinental Porto Palácio das Cardosas (Luxury) Central
 Porto; historic palace, refined elegance. From €350/night.
- Torel Avantgarde (Boutique) Arts district; bold design, river views,
 creative flair. From €280/night.

Activity: Porto Walking Tour – Discover Porto's azulejo-covered churches, bustling markets, and riverside charm with a local expert.

TIP: Porto's hills are steep; transfers can be arranged for guests who prefer to minimize walking.

Solution 2 Day 8: Porto & Surroundings

- Morning: Free time or optional guided art and architecture tour (Serralves Museum, Casa da Música).
- Afternoon: Private cooking class or gourmet lunch at a Michelin-starred restaurant.
- Evening: Sunset walk across the Dom Luís I Bridge, with city views.

Same hotel options as Day 7.

Activity: Private Cooking Class – Learn to prepare classic Portuguese dishes with a local chef, followed by a tasting menu dinner.

TIP: Porto's riverside can be lively in the evenings; enjoy a cocktail at a rooftop bar for a memorable sunset.

ಲೆ Day 9: Porto to the Algarve (Sun, Sea & Seclusion)

- Private transfer to Porto Airport (20 min), flight to Faro (1h), private
 transfer to Algarve hotel (45 min).
- Check-in and relax at your resort.
- Evening: Sunset cocktails overlooking the Atlantic.

Hotel options:

- Vila Vita Parc (Luxury) Porches; clifftop villas, lush gardens,
 Michelin dining. From €500/night.
- Conrad Algarve (Luxury) Quinta do Lago; sleek modern design,
 world-class spa, golf. From €450/night.
- Pine Cliffs Resort (Family/Luxury) Albufeira; spacious villas, golf, direct beach access. From €350/night.

Activity: Private Yacht Charter – Explore the Benagil Cave and hidden beaches along the Algarve coast.

TIP: The Algarve's sun is strong; pack sunscreen and a hat for all outdoor activities.

Day 10: Algarve - Beaches, Wellness & Departure

- Morning: Leisure at the resort, spa treatment, or golf.
- Optional: Guided kayak tour to Ponta da Piedade or beach picnic.
- Afternoon: Private transfer to Faro or Lisbon Airport for departure
 (Faro: 45 min; Lisbon: 2h30 by road or 1h flight).

Same hotel options as Day 9 (for late departures or extensions).

Activity: Kayak Tour to Ponta da Piedade – Paddle through sea caves and along dramatic cliffs, discovering the Algarve's wild beauty.

TIP: For late flights, request a late check-out or a day-use room to freshen up before departure.
