Custom Program

Day 1: Arrival in Lisbon




- **Morning:** Arrival at Lisbon airport. Private transfer (with child seats, approx. 30 min) to your accommodation in the historic Alfama district. Early check-in if possible.
- **Afternoon:** Light stroll through Alfama's winding streets. Option for a 1.5-hour guided family walking tour (suitable for all ages, stroller-friendly, low difficulty). Stop at a local pastelaria for a treat.
- **Evening:** Early dinner at a family-friendly restaurant with children's menu. Rest and settle in.
- **Highlight:** First sunset over the Tagus River from Miradouro de Santa Luzia—magical for all ages.

Day 2: Lisbon for Families

- **Highlight:** Evening lights of Porto reflected on the Douro—a magical family welcome.

 - **Highlight:** Art and nature in Serralves—relaxed family day.
 - TIP:** Pre-book workshops, suggest indoor alternatives for heat.

Day 13: Departure from Porto



- **Morning:** Private transfer to Porto airport (30 min, child seats, buffer for check-in).

- **Hotel options:** N/A
- **[To Customize]:** Confirm flight details, luggage needs, and airport assistance if needed.

✦ Alternative Options

- **Alternative Option 1:** Slower pace—add more rest days and longer stays in each region, especially for families with young children or if you wish to minimize packing/unpacking.
- **Alternative Option 2:** Focus on two regions only (e.g., Lisbon + Algarve or Lisbon + Porto) for deeper exploration, less travel, and more relaxation.
- **Alternative Option 3:** Include inland Alentejo or Serra da Estrela for nature and rural experiences, with eco-lodge stays and outdoor family adventures.

✦ Practical Info & Budget

- **Seasonality:** August is peak summer—expect hot, sunny days (28–35°C), especially inland and in the Algarve. Plan outdoor activities before 10am or after 5pm; midday (12–4pm) is best for rest or indoor activities. Beaches and attractions can be busy—pre-booking is essential. Bring hats, sunscreen, and refillable water bottles.
- **Comfort level:** Boutique, eco, and budget options—family suites or bungalows with pool, playground, and kitchen/kitchenette where possible.
- **Indicative budget breakdown:**
 - Adults: €1500 x 2 = €3000
 - Children (50% of adult rate): €750 x 2 = €1500
 - **Total family budget (estimated): €4500**
 - Includes: Accommodation (family rooms), private transfers with child seats, main family activities (entrance fees, boat tour, ZooMarine), most meals.
 - Excludes: International flights, personal expenses, optional upgrades (babysitting, surf lessons), travel insurance.
 - **Savings:** Compared to full adult pricing, you save approx. €1500 for children's discounts.
- **Health & safety:** Portugal is safe for families. Water is potable. Use sun protection, keep children hydrated, and avoid midday heat. Beaches are lifeguarded. Food is generally safe; avoid raw seafood

for young children. Bring any necessary medications.

- **Logistics:** All transfers include child seats (mandatory under 12 years/135cm). Stroller-friendly options available. Allow extra time for bathroom/snack breaks.
- **Visa:** For EU citizens, no visa needed. For other nationalities, check requirements in advance.
- **Partner verification and availability check recommended for final booking.**
