- **Evening:** Alfama Fado dinner (early seating, child-friendly).
- **Highlight:** Pastéis de nata workshop (ages 5+, 1 hour). Hands-on baking of iconic custard tarts with a local bakery. ~€60/family.

### **Day 3: Sintra – Palaces & Forests**




- **Morning:** Private transfer to Sintra (45 min). Visit Pena Palace (shuttle to top, stroller-friendly paths).

- **The Log Porto Hotel** (budget eco-hotel) – Antas, Porto. Timber construction, rooftop solar, modern design. From €80/night.

**TIP:** Fast train is comfortable and scenic; private car offers flexibility for luggage and stops.

## 📍 **Day 8: Porto – City of Bridges**



- **Morning:** Private city tour (adapted for kids: Livraria Lello, São Bento station, Bolhão Market).
- **Afternoon:** Boat cruise on the Douro (1h, all ages). Port wine cellars

(non-alcoholic tastings for kids).

- **Evening:** Dinner in Ribeira. Try francesinha (local specialty, mild version for kids).
- **Highlight:** River cruise under 6 bridges.

**TIP:** Choose a locally guided tour for insider stories and family-friendly pacing.

## 📍 **Day 9: Porto – World of Discovery**



● **Morning:** World of Discoveries museum (interactive, ages 4+, 2h).

- **Afternoon:** Crystal Palace Gardens (peacocks, playgrounds, city views).
- **Evening:** Free time, local café.
- **Highlight:** Hands-on history adventure.

**TIP:** Canto de Luz and NEYA Porto both offer organic breakfasts and family suites—perfect for a restful stay.

## **Day 10: Douro Valley – Vineyards & Villages**



- **Morning:** Private transfer to Douro Valley (1h30). Check into rural

guesthouse or eco-lodge (family suite, pool).

- **Magical Treehouse** (off-grid eco-lodge) – Lagos. Private bath, communal kitchen, hiking/bike paths, organic produce. From €220/night.
- **Cork Oak Cottage** (off-grid lodge) – Vila do Bispo. Solar-powered, lakes, zip lines, paddleboards, family activities. From €250/night.

**TIP:** Algarve eco-lodges fill up early in August—book as soon as possible for best selection.

## **Day 15: Algarve – Beach Bliss**



- 

**Morning:** Relax at Praia da Marinha (iconic cliffs, calm waters, lifeguards).

- **Afternoon:** Sandcastle building, swimming, optional SUP (ages 8+).
- **Evening:** Seafood dinner in local village.
