### 📍 Day 1: Arrival in Rome

- **47 Boutique Hotel** (Boutique) - Near major attractions. Green Globe certified, themed rooms, sustainable food, local products, green mobility. From €250-400/night.

**[To Customize]:** Arrival time, airport pickup preferences.

**TIP:** April–June and September–October are the best months for mild weather and fewer crowds in Rome.

## **Day 2: Rome – Ancient Wonders**



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**Morning: Private Colosseum, Forum & Palatine Tour (3h):**

Skip-the-line ancient history immersion with licensed guide.

**€100-150 per person.** Insider narratives and access to iconic sites.

- **Afternoon:** Leisurely lunch in Monti district, followed by time to explore artisan shops or relax at a café.
- **Evening:** Optional evening stroll to the Trevi Fountain and Spanish Steps.
- **Highlight:** Insider stories from your guide about ancient Rome.

**Accommodation Options:** Same as Day 1.

**[To Customize]:** Interest in art galleries or specific museums.

**TIP:** Book guides for authentic access and to avoid long lines at major attractions.

### **Day 3: Vatican & Baroque Rome**

**TIP:** Advance bookings for Vatican and Borghese Gallery are essential, especially in peak season.

## **Day 4: Rome to Florence – Renaissance Heart**



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**Morning:** High-speed train from Rome to Florence (1h30, first-class ticket, buffer for check-out and station transfer).

- **Afternoon: Guided Duomo, Signoria, Ponte Vecchio Walk (2-3h):** Renaissance intro with local guide, optional dome climb. **€70-110 per person.**
- **Evening:** Dinner in the Oltrarno district, known for artisan workshops.
- **Highlight:** Climbing Brunelleschi's Dome (optional, advance booking).

#### **Accommodation Options:**

- **The Hoxton, Florence (Boutique)** - Central Florence. Sustainable design hotel with local artisanal touches, energy-efficient practices.

From €250-400/night.

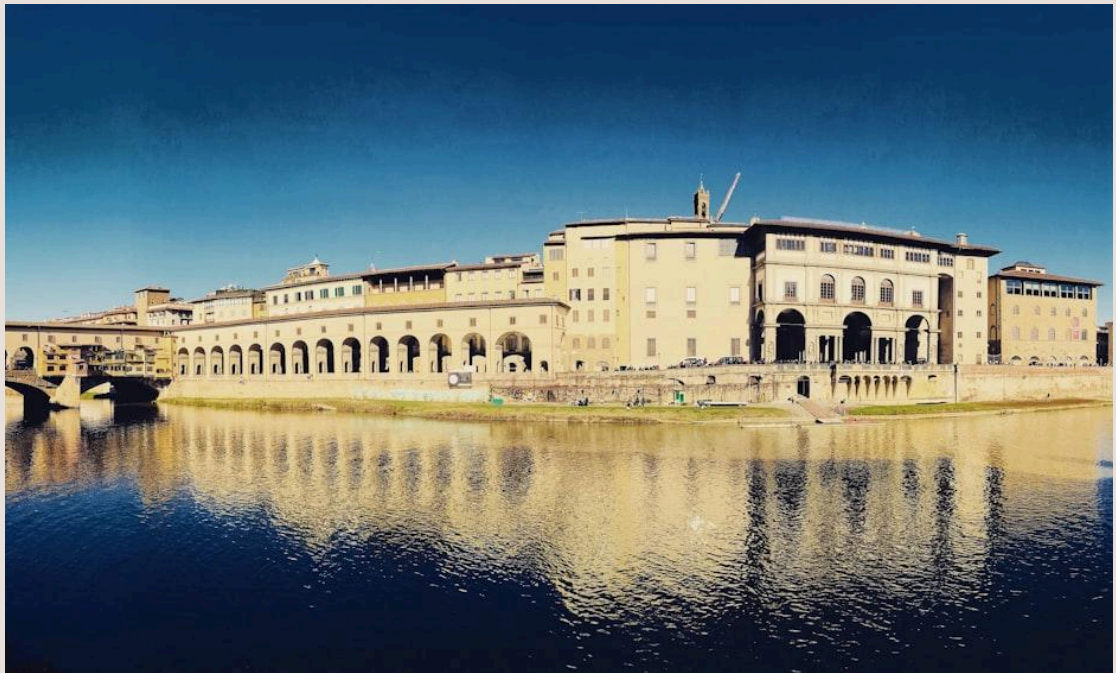
- **AdAstra** (Boutique) - Oltrarno district. Stylish garden villa with historic charm, supports local workshops. From €300-450/night.
- **Nerva Boutique Hotel** (Boutique) - Central Florence. Personalized design, organic breakfast with local ingredients. From €220-380/night.

**[To Customize]:** Art vs. food focus in Florence.

**TIP:** Central locations in Florence make solo exploration easy and safe.

Advance bookings for Uffizi and dome climb are highly recommended.

## 📍 **Day 5: Florence – Art & Tuscan Flavors**



● **Morning: Uffizi Gallery Guided Visit (2h):** Skip-the-line art tour +

artisan quarter stroll. **€90-140 per person.**

- **Afternoon: Tuscan Cooking Class or Wine Tasting (3-4h):** Hands-on with local enoteca, community-supported organic ingredients.

**€100-160 per person.**

- **Evening:** Leisure time or guided sunset walk to Piazzale Michelangelo.
- **Highlight:** Hands-on culinary experience (if desired).

**Accommodation Options:** Same as Day 4.

**[To Customize]:** Cooking vs. wine tasting preference.

**TIP:** Florence's artisan quarters are perfect for solo travelers interested in local crafts and food culture.

## **Day 6: Florence to Venice – Canals & Romance**



- **Morning:** High-speed train to Venice (2h, buffer for check-out and transfer to station).
- **Afternoon: Private Rialto, St. Mark's Intro Tour (2-3h):** Hidden alleys exploration with local guide. **€90-140 per person.**
- **Evening: Gondola Ride or Canal Aperitivo (1-2h):** Evening cultural immersion. **€80-130 per person.**
- **Highlight:** Navigating Venice's labyrinth with a local guide.

#### **Accommodation Options:**

- **The Venice Venice Hotel (Boutique)** - Venice proper. Zero-emission boutique with sustainable operations, authentic Venetian design.

From €350-500/night.

- **Ca' Pisani** (Boutique) - Dorsoduro district. Art deco boutique supporting local artisans. From €280-450/night.
- **Liassidi Wellness Suites** (Boutique) - Canal views. Boutique luxury with wellness focus, eco-elements. From €300-480/night.

**[To Customize]:** Interest in contemporary art (Peggy Guggenheim Collection).

**TIP:** Venice's Dorsoduro and canal-side hotels offer a quieter, more authentic experience for solo travelers.

## **Day 7: Venice – Islands & Hidden Corners**



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**Morning: Murano Glassblowing & Burano Lace-Making Boat Tour**

(4h): Islands visit, meet artisans. **€120-180 per person.**

- **Afternoon:** Leisure time for shopping or exploring lesser-known sestieri (neighborhoods).
- **Evening:** Farewell dinner at a canal-side osteria.
- **Highlight:** Meeting local artisans and discovering Venice's quieter side.

**Accommodation Options:** Same as Day 6.

**[To Customize]:** Interest in photography, artisan workshops.

**TIP:** Private boat tours to Murano and Burano are a must for authentic

artisan encounters and colorful photography.

## **Day 8: Departure from Venice**



- **Morning:** Private transfer to Venice Marco Polo Airport (VCE) or onward travel (buffer for boat transfer and check-in, ~1h).
- **Afternoon:** End of services – flexible based on your flight time.
- **Highlight:** Final stroll along the canals or last espresso in a piazza.

**[To Customize]:** Departure time, possible extension to Milan or Lake Como.

**TIP:** Allow at least 1 hour for boat transfer to the airport; Venice's labyrinthine layout makes advance planning essential.

## ✦ Customizable Options

- Upgrade to 5-star boutique hotels or historic palazzi.
- Private driver for intercity transfers instead of trains.
- Special interest guides (art historian, food expert, photographer).
- Hands-on experiences: Vespa tour in Tuscany, pasta-making in Rome.
- Day trip to Cinque Terre or Amalfi Coast (with overnight extension).
- Pre-trip concierge call to refine your interests.

**TIP:** Your €2000 budget fits 7-8 days with boutique stays (~€250/night), guiding, and high-speed trains. Adjust hotel category or reduce private guiding for more savings.

- **Best Season:** April–June and September–October for mild weather and fewer crowds.
- **Comfort:** All boutique hotels with en-suite bathrooms, central locations, and breakfast included.
- **Health/Visa:** No visa required for most nationalities for stays up to 90 days (TBD for your passport); standard travel insurance recommended.
