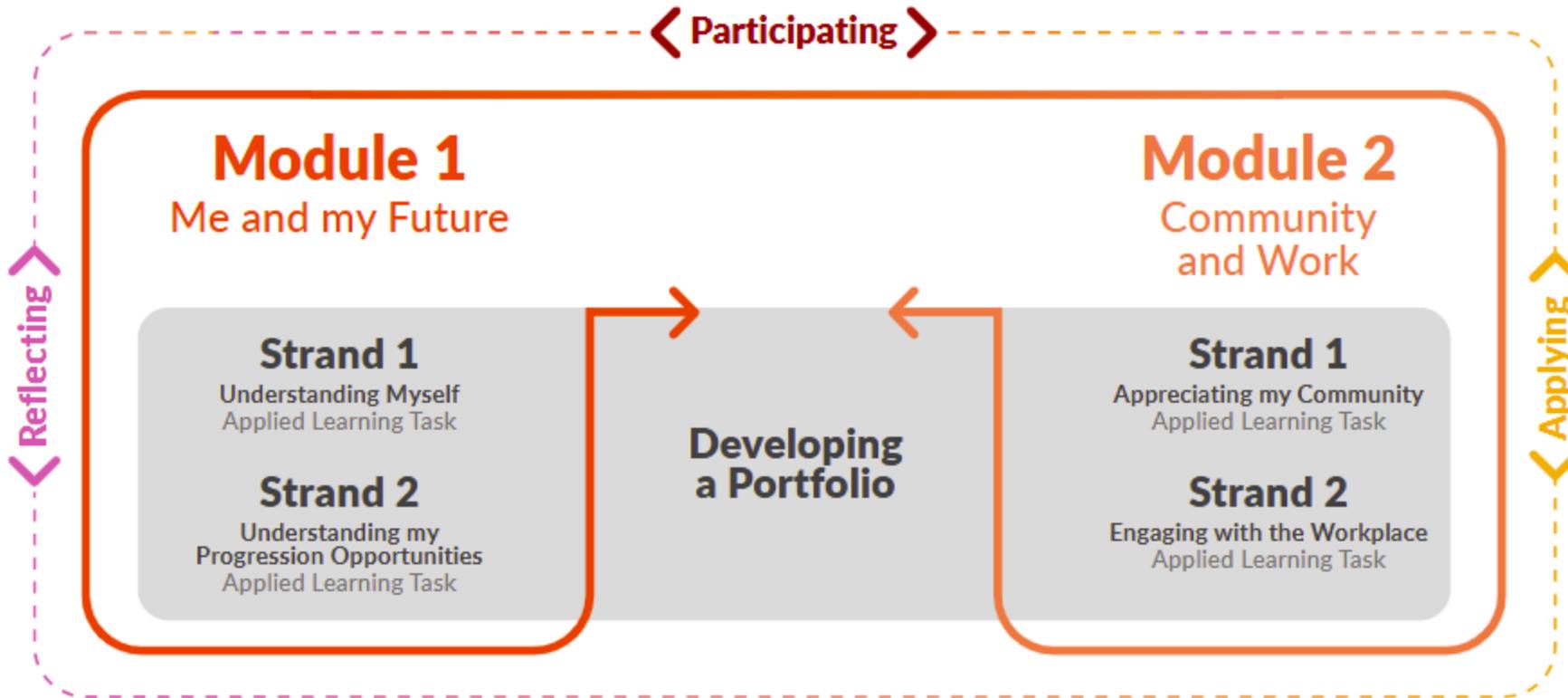


Life Community Work (LCW)

60% is awarded through a Portfolio in Action



This Portfolio is based on the learning experiences of 4 Applied Learning Tasks and the Digital Portfolio which is produced over the two years.

CAO POINTS FOR LCW

LCW AWARD

UNIVERSITIES & INSTITUTES OF TECHNOLOGY

Distinction (80 - 100%)

66 points (equivalent to grade H4 in Higher Level)
grade O1 in Ordinary Level = 56 points.

Merit (65 - 79%)

46 points (equivalent to grade H6 in Higher Level / grade O2 in Ordinary Level).

Pass (50 - 64%)

28 points (equivalent to grade O4 in Ordinary Level).

Advantages of taking LCW



For CAO purposes, the points achieved in **six** subjects can be used. If a student wishes, they can use the points achieved in LCW as one of these six subjects. If a student performs poorly on one of their regular Leaving Certificate subjects on the day of the exam, they can swap this disappointing result for the result achieved in the Links exam.



As mentioned earlier, 60% of the LCW course is awarded for their Portfolio in Action which is based on their learning from the four Applied Tasks completed over the two years. The remaining 40% is examined in a written paper held in 6th year.



Apart from its value in contributing to the overall points achieved by a student, the LCW course develops skills involving IT, report writing, case studies, interview techniques and teamwork, all of which are essential for third level and in employment. The LCW course provides an opportunity for students to become better informed regarding career choices.
