From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

One of the most heartfelt questions I'm asked, often by parents and grandparents, but also by others who carry deep love and concern, is this: "How can I help my loved ones who have stepped away from the Church find their way back?"

It's a question that comes from a place of love, hope, and sometimes even heartache. And while the answer is rarely simple, I want to begin by acknowledging the truth that each person's faith journey is Sacred and personal. God, in His love, gave us the beautiful gift of free will, and with that comes the freedom and the responsibility to make our own choices. As hard as that can be for those watching someone they love walk away, it's important to hold that truth with reverence.

That said, I believe there's always room for healing, for understanding, and for grace to enter in. When someone distances themselves from the Church, it's rarely because they simply "lost interest in faith." More often, there's a deeper story: A place of pain, confusion, disappointment, or disconnection. It might be due to wounds caused by others within the Church, feeling judged or unwelcome, experiencing hypocrisy, or simply feeling like their needs weren't met in a time of struggle. These hurts are real. They matter. And they deserve to be acknowledged with compassion, not criticism. I also recognize that some among us are still here physically, attending Mass regularly, but may feel spiritually distant or unsure why they keep coming. That too is a quiet struggle, and it's one that deserves tenderness and space for reflection.

Not long ago, a parishioner came to me with a beautiful idea that came from a place of love for those who feel like they don't belong, or who are on the edge of walking away, or who already have. Together, we felt a strong call to do something that reflects the heart of Christ: to reach out, to listen, and to build bridges. That's exactly what Jesus did 2,000 years ago. He met people where they were. He heard their pain. He walked with them.

In that same spirit, we're offering two upcoming gatherings that will be a safe, welcoming space for those who are struggling with the Church or questioning their place within it. These gatherings will be a time to be heard, and also to hear anew the message of God's love and the hope that still lives within the Church.

Both sessions will offer the same experience, we're simply offering two options to make it easier for more people to attend:

- Saturday, August 30th at 10:00 AM
- Tuesday, September 2nd at 7:00 PM

In the coming weeks, I'll share more details, but I wanted to invite you now to begin praying about who in your life might benefit from such a space. Think of those you love and please invite them to attend one of these sessions. Please invite anyone you know who may be hurting, doubting, or just in need of someone to say, "You matter. You are seen. You are loved."

The heart of this effort is simple:
To bring healing. To extend invitation. To open doors.

Please know this: God sees your concern. The Church sees the need. And I, too, care deeply for the people who matter deeply to you. Together, we want to gently knock on hearts that may feel closed or unsure and offer the possibility of opening them to healing, to hope, and most of all, to Jesus.

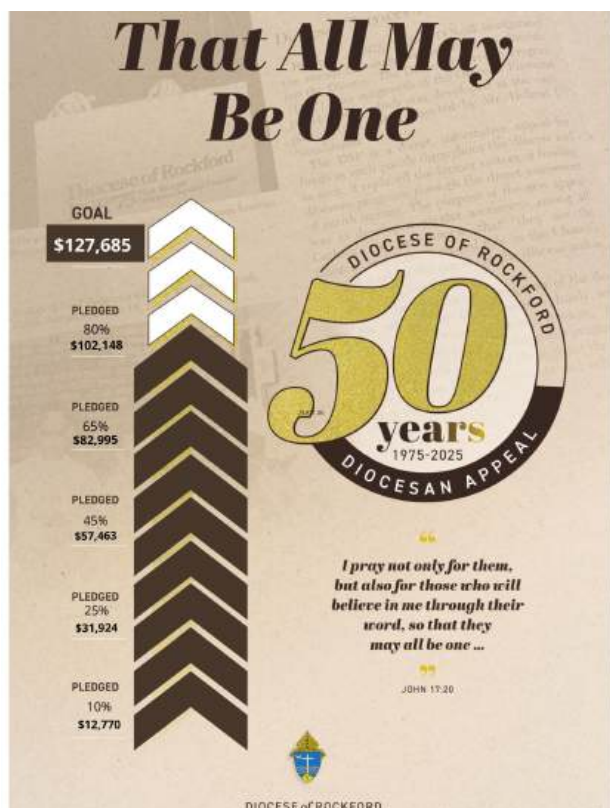

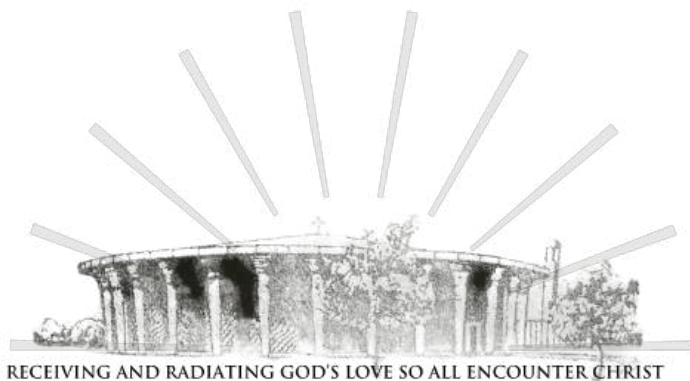

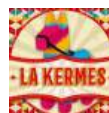
