From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

God never meant for us to go through life on our own. From the very beginning, He created us to live in relationship with Him and with one another. We sometimes forget this and try to carry everything by ourselves: worries, struggles, even our joys. But God reminds us that not only is He with us, He has also given us the gift of other people to walk alongside us.

Our homes are the first place where this community is lived out. Family life isn't always perfect, but it is the "school of love" where we learn patience, forgiveness, and encouragement. Even something simple like sitting down for dinner together can become a holy moment when we listen, laugh, and share our hearts. That's where God shows up: right in the middle of ordinary family life.

Let's remember, then, that we don't have to do it all alone. God is always with us, and He works through the people He's placed around us—our families, friends, and parish.

I encourage you as often as possible (every day would be great!) to open up and share your hearts with each other around the dinner table. Here are some questions that can start a conversation.

- Where did I see God in my day today?
- Did I try to handle something on my own that I could have shared?
- Who encouraged me today, or who did I encourage?
- What's one thing I'm thankful for about our family?
- How can we remind each other that God is with us?

It may seem awkward, forced, or even uncomfortable at first, but please stick with it as it'll get easier and at the same time I'm willing to bet that family life and your relationships together just might get easier and more fruitful as well! May your homes be filled with God's presence, and may you find strength and joy in sharing life together.

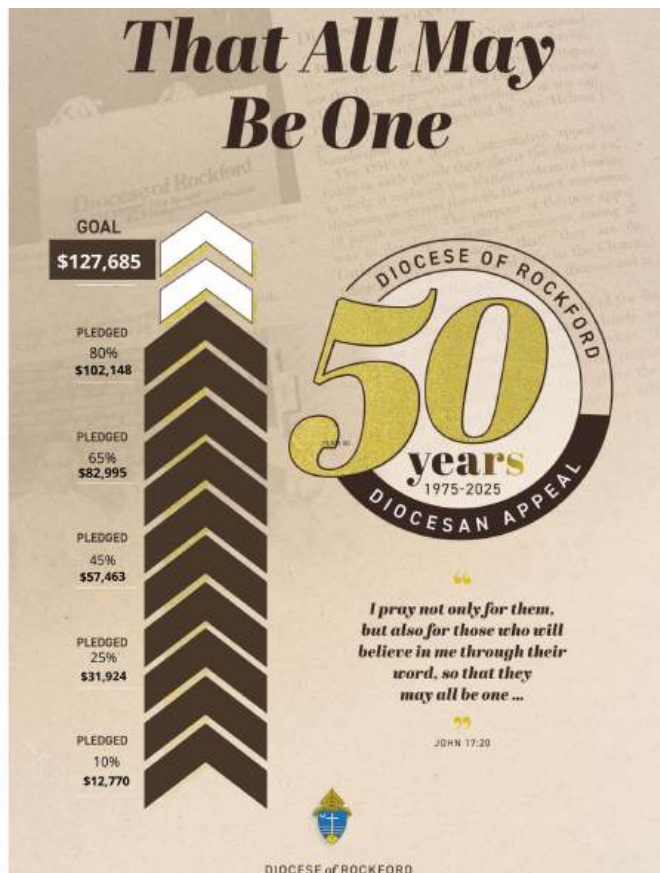

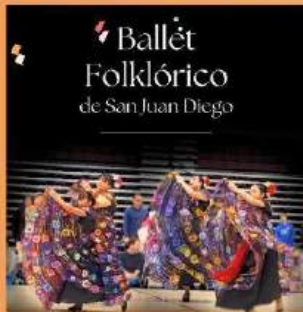

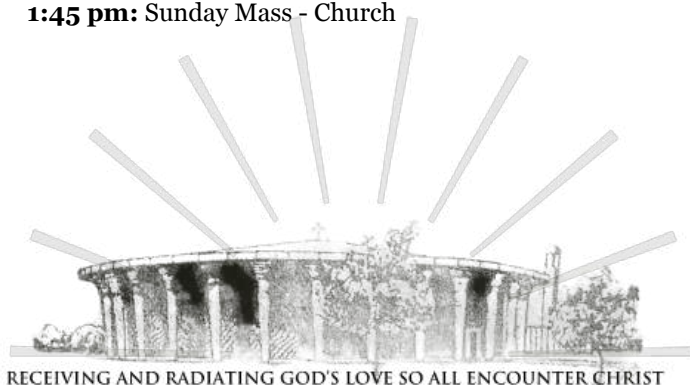
