From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

A few days ago, the Church celebrated the Feast of Saint Augustine, one of the greatest teachers of our faith. Augustine's life was a journey marked by searching, struggle, and at last, a profound encounter with the mercy of God. His most famous words still speak with power today:

"You have made us for yourself, O God, and our hearts are restless until they rest in you."

Augustine knew what it meant to chase after happiness in the wrong places. Before his conversion, he sought fulfillment in ambition, pleasure, philosophy, and success. And yet, none of it could quiet the deep longing within him. It was only when he surrendered to Christ that he found the peace he had always sought.

This message is timeless. In our own lives, how often do we find ourselves restless? We may think: "If I just accomplish this, buy that, or reach this milestone, then I'll be at peace." But like Augustine, we discover that the human heart was made for more. It was made for God.

The Feast of Saint Augustine invites us to reflect: Where am I restless? Where do I seek peace apart from God? His story reminds us that true rest, joy, and purpose are not found in possessions or achievements, but in relationship with the One who created us out of love.

As a community, may we be encouraged by Augustine's witness. His conversion is a sign of hope: no matter how far we may feel from God, His grace is always stronger. And when we finally open our hearts, we discover the fulfillment we were made for.

Let us pray this week for the grace to turn our restlessness into a longing for God and to allow that longing to lead us closer to Him.

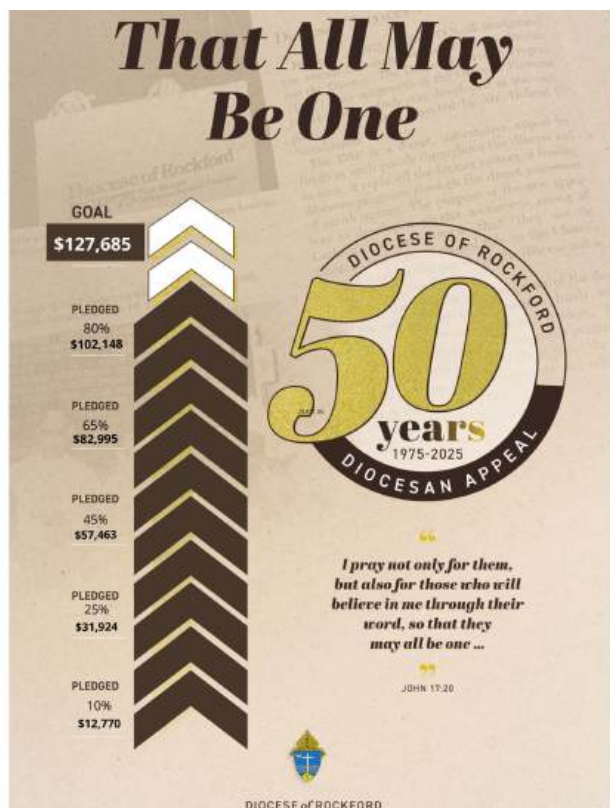

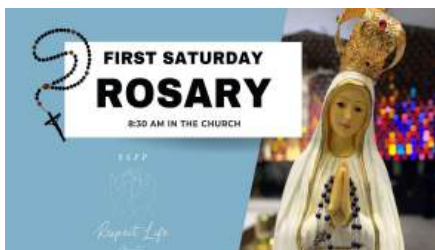
That Man is You - Fall Semester

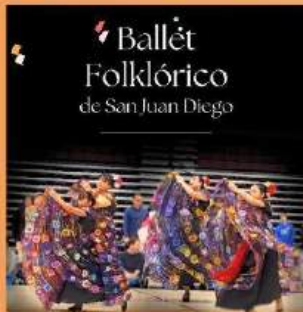
