From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

In the Gospel, Jesus says:

“If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself, take up his cross daily, and follow me”

At first, these words may sound heavy, as if following Christ means only hardship. But hidden in His invitation is a profound promise: He never asks us to carry our crosses alone.

When Jesus calls us to “take up your cross,” He is also saying, “I will walk beside you. I will strengthen you. I will transform your suffering into life.” Our crosses, whether illness, grief, family struggles, or daily trials, are never meaningless. Because Christ carried His cross to Calvary, He has already walked the road of suffering and won the victory of the Resurrection.

The saints remind us that when we embrace our crosses with faith, we discover Christ more intimately. St. John Paul II wrote that suffering, united with Christ, becomes “a sharing in the redemptive suffering of the Savior.” Our burdens become places where grace breaks through.

So, when life feels overwhelming, remember: the One who commands us to carry the cross also carries it with us. His words are not a demand but a guarantee: “I am with you always, even to the end of the age”

This week, let us not run from our crosses, but lift them up with trust, knowing that every cross carried with Christ leads to Easter morning.

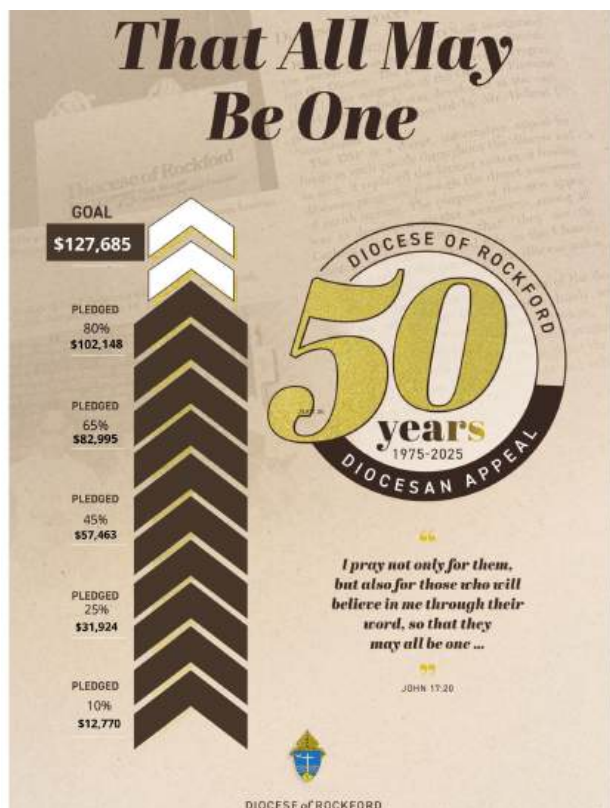

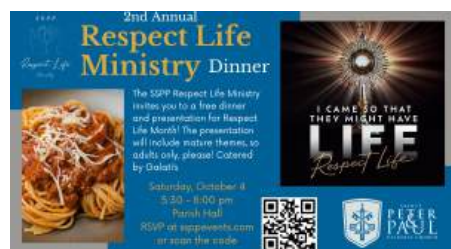

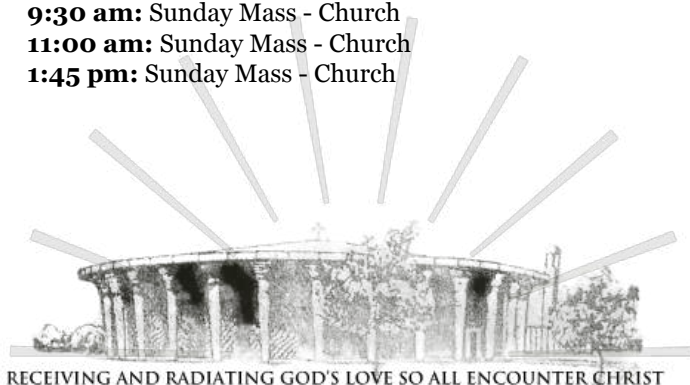
