From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

My favorite thing in the world is leading others to receive God's love into their lives in a way that roots them in the truth of who they are as His beloved Sons and Daughters. That's why I love being a priest! And I intentionally say that it's my favorite thing in the world, because the truth is that this reception of God's live giving love and truth can be received anywhere in the world. We of course can be loved by God and come to grasp His love for us right here in Cary at SSPP, but God also reaches out and touches lives all throughout the globe. Now, just like music can be heard in different styles on different radios stations, God has sang different songs of His same love throughout the centuries. This is why I love leading pilgrimages and why I'm excited to be taking a group to France this upcoming May 3rd-15th. I've had people from previous parishes and previous pilgrimages inquire about this trip, saying that they want to sign-up, BUT I want to give the first chance to sign-up to those of you from Saints Peter and Paul because pilgrimage is a great way for me to get to know my people better as well as to help set our parish on fire one person at a time. For that reason, I'm going to limit registration to our own parish for the next 2 weeks. So, registration will open up to anyone after Oct. 5th but is exclusive to you for now. Please pray and if you're interested don't wait as space is limited.

Have an amazing week and know that we certainly don't have to wait till May for God to reach out and impact our lives!

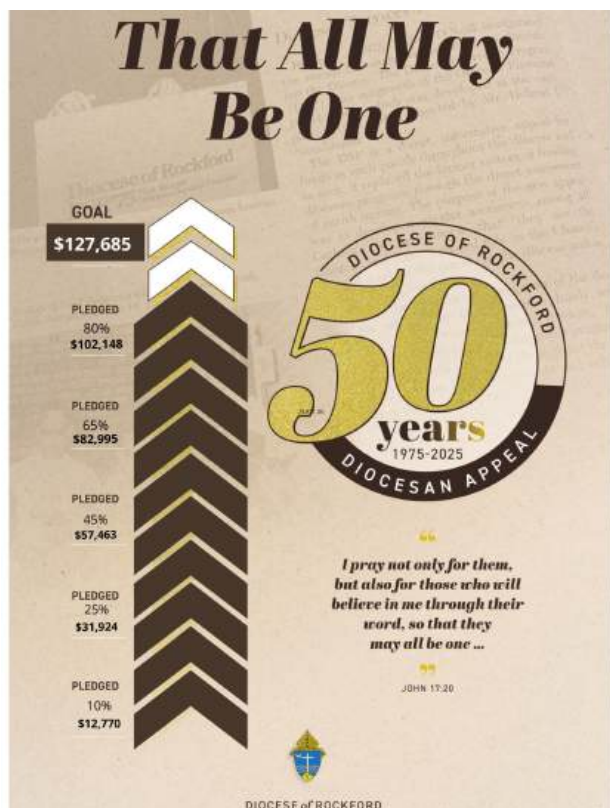

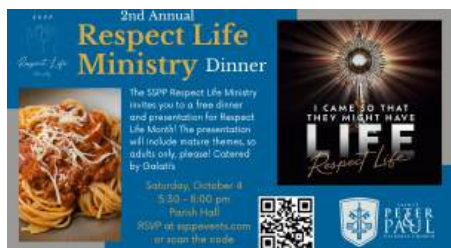

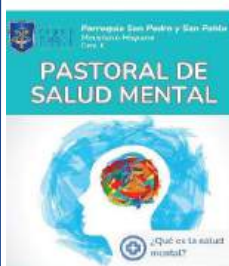
