From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke

Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

I think it's clear to everyone who hears any news whatsoever that there have been a lot of troubling things out in the world lately. Some of these things have simply involved people and their own personal issues, some have been due to disagreements between people, and others have been motivated by politics. Within all of this, as you might imagine, I constantly field questions about why I have said or haven't said certain things, and have heard many people make passionate comments about our country's political climate. So, I figured it might be helpful to briefly state what the Church teaches about her role when it comes to involvement in politics.



The Catechism of the Catholic Church, Paragraph 2245 (CCC 2245) states: "The Church, because of her commission and competence, is not to be confused in any way with the political community. She is both the sign and the safeguard of the transcendent character of the human person. "The Church respects and encourages the political freedom and responsibility of the citizen."

By stating that the Church, because of her commission, is NOT to be confused in any way with the political community means that the Church is not to make statements that directly refer to politics. It is important not to cause this "confusion" that the Catechism warns against. This is why it states that each citizen has their own freedom and responsibility when it comes to politics.

The Church, of course, still does have a duty and responsibility to educate and teach the Truth of what Jesus taught when it comes to issues of right and wrong. For this reason, in the very next paragraph, CCC 2246 states:

"It is a part of the Church's mission "to pass moral judgments even in matters related to politics, whenever the fundamental rights of man or the salvation of souls requires it. The means, the only means, she may use are those which are in accord with the Gospel and the welfare of all men according to the diversity of times and circumstances."

Here it is clearly stated that the Church's mission IS to pass moral judgments. This mission to judge in this way goes across the board: There is no realm where the Church does not have the authority to pass moral judgments. However, in 2246, it is explicitly spelled out for the sake of clarity that one specific area where the Church is to make these judgments is: "in matters related to politics." By saying matters "related" to politics means that even if a matter could be labeled "political" for example: the dignity of human life, the nature of marriage, the anthropology of man and woman, etc. - That while these matters may be "related" to politics, as in there being political debate on the "matters," that the Church's mission is in fact to pass moral judgment on these issues or matters in their own right. CCC 2246 is not saying that the Church's mission is to pass moral judgment on "political matters," rather it is on "matters related to politics." The Church is never to be political, even though at times people may accuse her of doing so, due to faithfully passing moral judgment on issues that politicians and politics weigh in on. In other words, politics doesn't automatically get a monopoly on an issue simply because an issue leaks into their realm of debate and conjecture. The Church must and should comment, teach, lead, and guide on the truth of these issues, albeit without doing so in a matter that gets political. I spell this out in this way because, at times, speaking about the issues versus the politics behind the issues can be confused. The easiest way to sum it up is by saying that the Church needs to carry out the mission of CCC 2246 while at the same time holding in balance what CCC 2245 says as well.

I hope this clarifies things in our quest to promote, teach, and stand for the Truth of the Gospel of Jesus in our world today.




McHenry County National Life Chain






