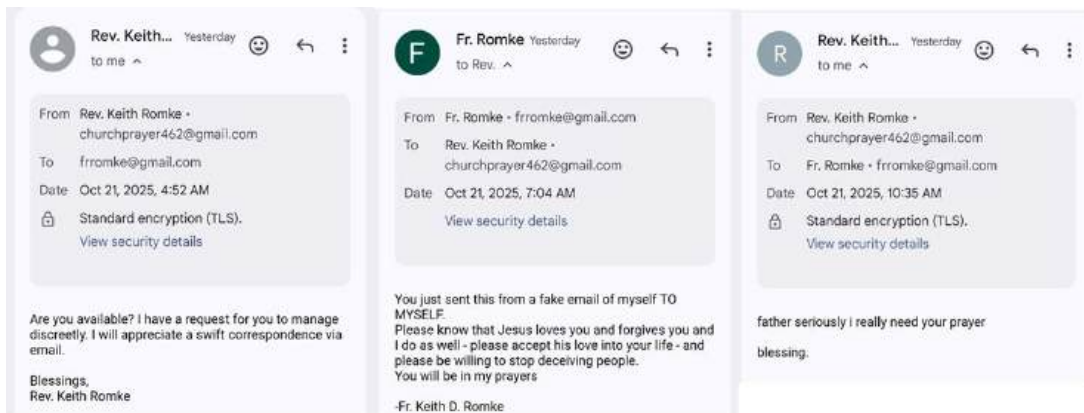
From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

The world can be a scary, difficult, gross, and mean place! More and more scammers are popping up all over the place trying to deceive us and steal our money (and our peace of mind!) At least once a month I'll have someone email me asking me if I'm in need of help because they've received an email from "me" claiming that I need gift cards, or that I'm trapped in Europe and need money, or other schemes. 100% of the time, truly ONE HUNDRED PERCENT of the time my answer is "NO – that's not from me." What happens is that people create a fake email address in my name, so it looks like it's coming from me, but I have NOTHING whatsoever to do with it. Sometimes people will message me to warn me that my email has been hacked – that is not the case either – MY personal email address is perfectly safe and untouched – it's that someone has created a new, fake email address using my name. Unfortunately I can't do anything to stop it. But what I can do is teach you how to spot it, and I want to do so, not only for instances with requests from any version of "fake me" (unfortunately there are many versions of "fake me.") But also to hopefully help you to see the red flags in other similar situations so that you don't fall trap to any other scams.

My prompting for sharing this is that I had a new situation pop up the other day: an email FROM MYSELF asking me to reach out to myself to handle something discreetly! (I was laughing so hard when I realized what was happening) I'm sharing the screenshots of the email with you so that you can see what happened. The fake "Rev. Keith Romke" name came from the email address churchprayer462@gmail.com . . . GUESS WHAT: That's NOT my email address. You can see that this fake account sent the email to fromke@gmail.com. The reason I received this email is because fromke.com IS my real email! address. If you ever want to email me you should email me at fromke@gmail.com – because that IS my email . . . AND if you EVER get an email FROM "me" that is from an address other than fromke@gmail.com you can be 100% sure that it isn't from me and that I don't need help (although I always appreciate the help of prayers!)



Final note: I could have sent a nasty response to the person who is trying to despicably and callously steal from people using me as the ruse. Did it upset me? YES – for sure! But we are always called to respond to those who upset us with the charity of Christ. I'm sure we all have plenty of people who upset us, whether it's family, co-workers, politicians, or any other people we encounter or hear about. Sharing nasty words, wishing harm upon them, even letting their actions STEAL our peace (which probably happens to us frequently even if we never get stolen from in a phishing scam) is never good. The response we are called to is to pray for them. I invite you to read the emails between "fake me" and "real me" to see what can happen when we let Christ lead the way. I pray that you can find any peace that has been stolen from you, that you can pray for those who upset you, and that we all can continue to build up unity rather than being swept up into the free-fall of division that is plaguing our society today.

Be assured that the "Real Me" hopes you have a great week and that I'll be praying for you.

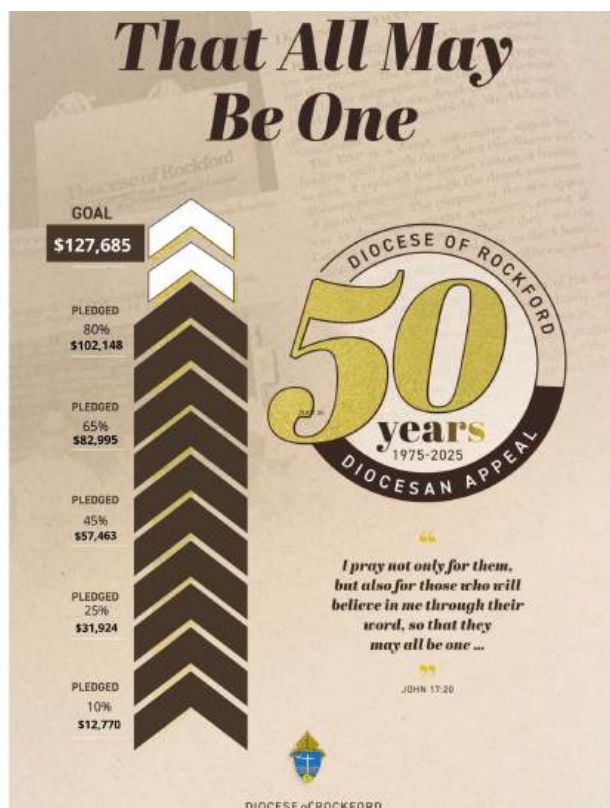

HOLIDAY GIVING AT SSPP



The Christmas season is quickly approaching, and we look forward to the generosity of the people of SS. Peter and Paul to once again help people in need right here in our own communities. Last year, our parish donated \$12,225 and provided Christmas to 78 households, which included 232 people. This incredible generosity provided hope and joy for these “least ones” that Jesus calls us to serve. It is another way that we can help keep Christ in Christmas by providing the opportunity to allow families to purchase their own gifts for their Christmas celebrations.

There are 3 ways to give to the parish Christmas Giving program. The easiest way is by donating online at our parish website. Simply go to our parish website, www.peterpaulchurchcary.org, and select “Give” and then scroll down to “Christmas Giving Program”. To donate by cash or check, put your donation in an envelope marked Christmas Giving. These can be dropped in the collection basket or dropped off at the parish office. Finally, if you wish to buy gift cards and donate them directly, put them in envelopes and drop them in the collection basket or at the parish office. If you want to purchase the gift cards, please purchase Walmart cards in \$25, \$50, or \$100 denominations. Walmart cards allow our friends in need the most value and flexibility to make their Christmas purchases.

Some of you also like to purchase gifts for families, and once again, The Giving Door will be taking sign-ups from the parish. The Giving Door table will be available after Masses on **10/26 & 11/2**. The Society of Saint Vincent de Paul will also be manning tables at upcoming Masses to answer any questions about the SSPP Christmas Giving program and to collect your donations. Watch the bulletin and Mass announcements for those dates.

We will be collecting donations through Sunday, December 7th but please don't wait. We would like to know in advance what help we can provide as our lists of people in need arrive. Once again, thank you for your generosity. We look forward to spreading the joy of Christmas to our neighbors in need.

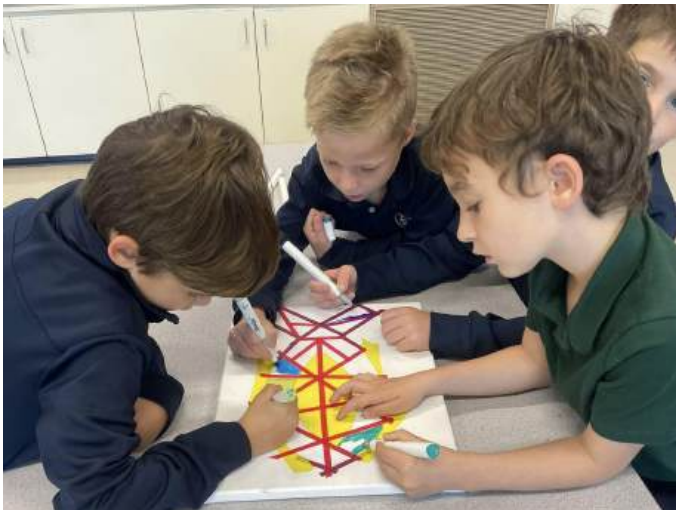
