From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke

Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

As we enter the First Sunday of Advent, the Church invites us into a season marked by hope, quiet expectation, and a renewed longing for Christ. Advent is not simply a countdown to Christmas: it's a spiritual pilgrimage. Each candle we light, each prayer we offer, each act of charity we choose becomes a step closer to welcoming Christ more deeply into our hearts and lives. I want to share with you a handful of ways to make the most of the season:



- Embrace the Gift of Stillness

In a world that becomes busier and louder this time of year, Advent calls us to intentional quiet. Set aside even five minutes a day for silence: no music, no phone, no list-making. Simply breathe and rest in God's presence. Stillness helps us hear the "small whispering voice" of the Lord and recognize the places where He desires to draw near.

- Reawaken Holy Expectation

The First Sunday of Advent shines with the theme of hope. Not wishful thinking, but a confident trust that God is faithful. Ask yourself: Where is God inviting me to hope again? What promise do I need to cling to? Advent reminds us that Christ comes not only at Christmas, not only at the end of time, but every day, in grace, in Scripture, in the sacraments, and in the people around us.

- Make Room for Christ

The season of Advent is an opportunity to declutter not only our homes but also our hearts. Are there habits, resentments, or distractions that crowd out God's peace? This is a wonderful time to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation and begin anew. Making room for Christ transforms not just our December, but our lives.

- Pray With the Advent Wreath

If you have an Advent wreath at home, let it become the heart of your family's prayer this season. Lighting the first candle, symbolizing hope, can be a powerful reminder that Christ is the light who pierces every darkness. Pray together as a family, or if you live alone, use it as a gentle anchor for daily prayer.

- Practice Small Acts of Love

Advent prepares us for the coming of Love Himself. Every act of kindness, especially the hidden, inconvenient ones, helps shape our hearts to resemble Christ's. Look for small ways to serve quietly: a phone call to someone lonely, a patient response when you are tired, a donation to a family in need. These little offerings become gifts laid at the manger.

- Let Scripture Be Your Guide

The readings this Sunday remind us to "stay awake" and be ready for the Lord. Consider reading the daily Mass readings throughout Advent or praying with one of the Gospels. God's Word has a way of opening our eyes and stirring our hearts exactly where we need it most.

As we begin this beautiful season, may we walk with renewed hope and joyful expectation. May our hearts grow more still, our hands more generous, and our spirits more awake to the presence of Christ. And may this Advent be not just a countdown to Christmas, but a time of true spiritual renewal.






