From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

This week I was thinking about the gift of Advent and the fact that from the start of the first Mass on the first Sunday of Advent the first candle on the wreath is lit. We start with light right off the bat: We don't have to wait a week or any amount of time before the light is available and shining brightly. Of course, over time as we prepare our hearts and as Christmas draws nearer, the increased light that pours forth from each extra candle represents the difference that Jesus is making in our hearts! We are so blessed to have Jesus in our lives guiding us with His light which IS His presence.

As St. John tells us:

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things came to be through Him, and without Him nothing came to be. What came to be through him was life, and this life was the light of the human race; the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it." (Jn. 1:1-5)

Let Jesus shine in and through you, and when you feel like your life is surrounded in darkness look to the Light because Jesus IS there!

One very bright source of light for me in my life is my great friend Fr. Gary Caster! I am very excited that he will be coming next week to give our Advent Mission. He'll be preaching all of the Masses next weekend and then giving presentations Sunday-Wednesday: December 14th, 15th, and 16th, each night at 7:00 p.m. PLEASE give your heart the gift of coming, resting in the church from the busyness of the season, and listening to him speak of God's love for us. All the time you hear me say "Let God Love You!" I'll admit that I stole that line from Fr. Caster! The mission is titled – Holy Mary: Icon of Advent – and he describes the experience he'll be offering as: "Learning from Our Lady about dispositions that we should have as disciples of Jesus, who await being fully united with him in Glory." YOU DO NOT WANT TO MISS THIS! Please come and "LET GOD LOVE YOU!"

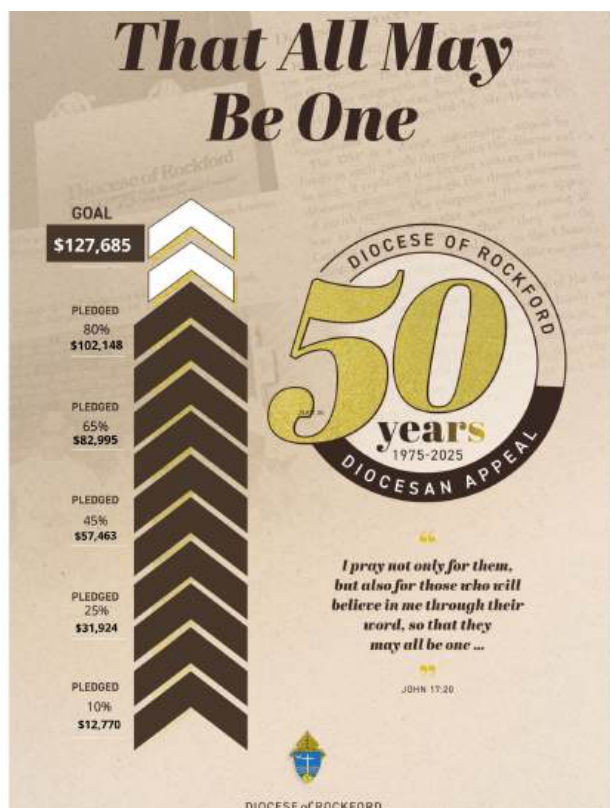

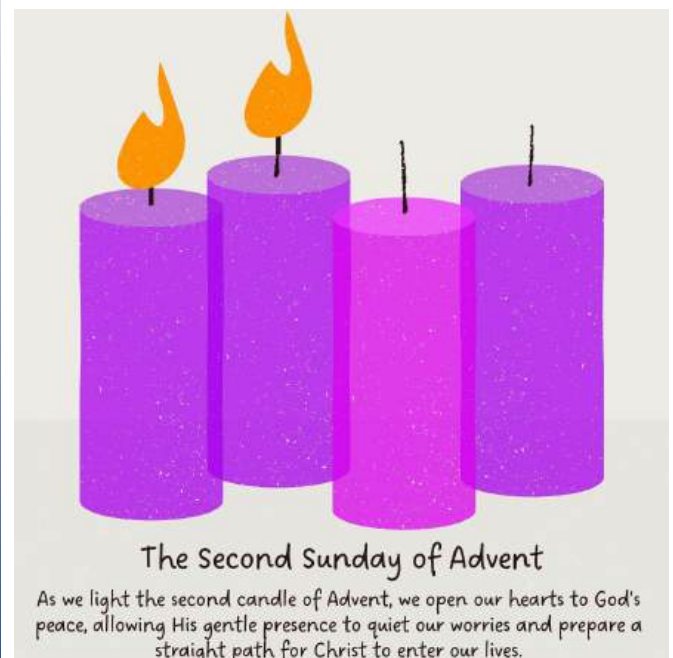
