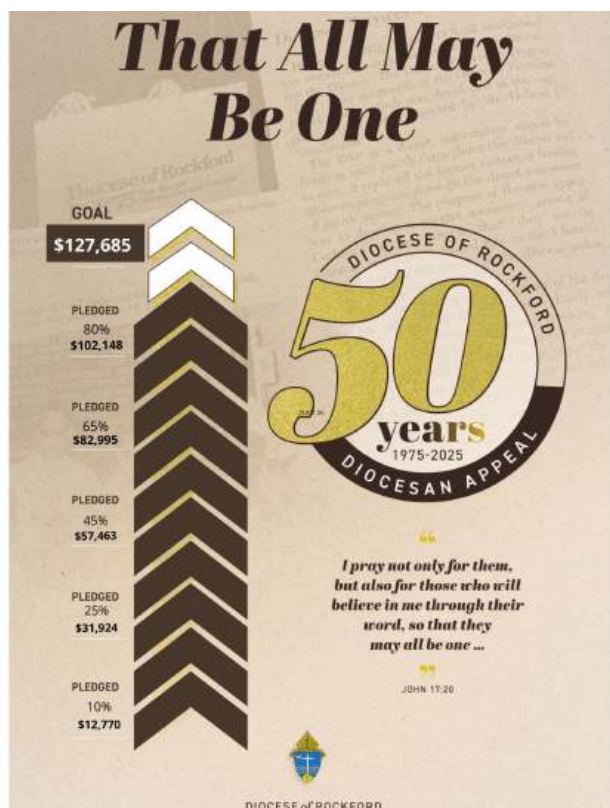

Longest Night Prayer Service

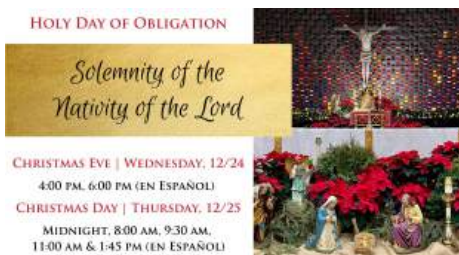

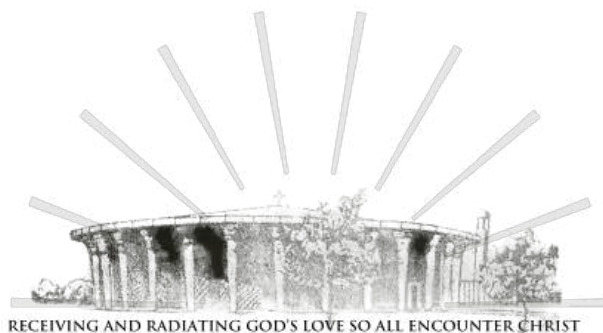
