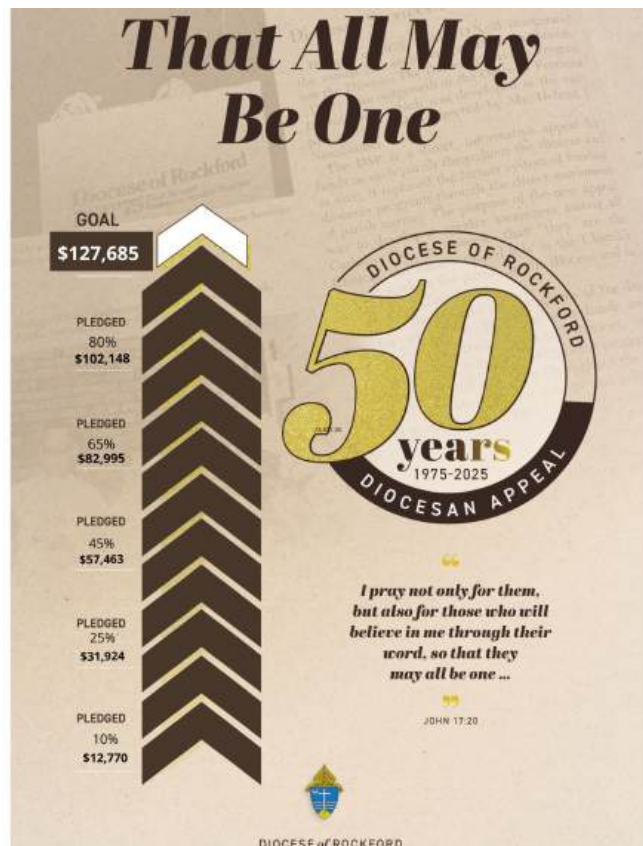

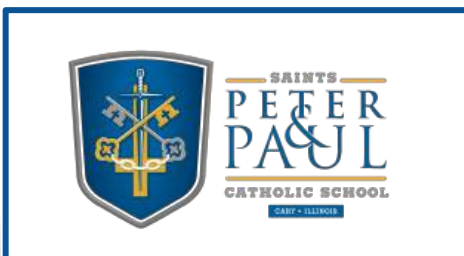
1st Tuesday Adoration
