From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke

Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

The Feast of the Epiphany begins our year with light. The Magi arrive in Bethlehem not because they had every answer, but because they trusted the star enough to follow it. God revealed Himself to them step by step, teaching us that faith often means moving forward even while we are still waiting.




As we enter a new year, many of us carry prayers that remain unanswered and struggles that have not yet found resolution. It can be tempting to measure God's love by how quickly things change. Epiphany gently corrects that instinct. God's love is not proven by speed, but by fidelity.

This year, consider making a different kind of resolution: To believe that you are loved perfectly and infinitely by the Sacred Heart of Jesus. To believe that His love reaches you in the exact way and at the exact time that you need, even when the outcome you hope for has not yet appeared.

The Sacred Heart of Jesus is a Heart that waits with us. It is never distant, never impatient, never withholding love as a test. When we are asked to wait, it is not because we are forgotten, but because God is working more deeply than we can yet see.

Epiphany reminds us that Christ has already come near. The light is already shining. May this year be shaped by the quiet, daily choice to trust that you are held in the Heart of Jesus: Fully known, fully loved, and never alone, even in the waiting.
