From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

Each time we gather for Mass, we hear the profound words spoken by John the Baptist and echoed by the priest before Holy Communion: “Behold the Lamb of God, behold Him who takes away the sins of the world.” These words are familiar to us, so familiar in fact, that we may hear them without truly stopping to behold.

To behold is more than to glance or to notice. To behold means to pause, to fix our gaze, to allow what is before us to shape our hearts. In a world filled with constant noise, images, and demands for our attention, we spend much of our lives beholding many things: screens, schedules, worries, achievements, and distractions that easily surround us. Yet how often do we intentionally take time to behold the One who alone gives life meaning?

The Lamb of God is not only present on the altar at Mass; He desires to dwell within us. But this presence requires attentiveness. It requires silence, prayer, and a willingness to turn our eyes away from what is fleeting so we may focus on what is eternal. When we neglect this, our faith can become routine rather than relationship.

This invites an important and honest question for each of us: Do we seriously consider, on a deep level, the need to look for and behold the presence of the Lamb of God in our hearts and in our lives on a daily basis? Or do we assume His presence without seeking Him, trusting that He will fit into whatever space remains after everything else has claimed our attention?

Beholding the Lamb of God daily may be as simple as beginning the day with a short prayer, spending a few quiet moments before the Blessed Sacrament, reflecting on Sacred Scripture, or examining where Christ was present in our joys and struggles. These moments of beholding slowly transform us. They re-center our lives on Christ and help us recognize His presence even amid the busyness of the world.

As we continue our journey of faith, may we ask for the grace not merely to look, but truly to behold: To behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world, and to allow Him to shape our hearts, our choices, and our lives.
