From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke

Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

In the middle of the week long celebration of "Catholic Schools Week" that we are concluding today, I had the opportunity to preach at a Mass with all of the Catholic school students in the McHenry Deanery present. As I prayed about what to share with them, when hit me was that they needed to hear WHY their Faith is important and especially to hear that attending a Catholic school is not simply about having an extra class added onto their schedules: Religion! That the goal of our learning about Jesus isn't just to learn ABOUT Him, but to truly get to know HIM.



At the heart of the Catholic faith is this core truth: we do not practice our faith merely to learn about God, but to know Him, love Him, and live in friendship with Him. Everything we do as Catholics: coming to Mass, receiving the sacraments, praying, learning the faith, and teaching our children, flows from this purpose.

We need to come to Church not out of habit, obligation, or tradition alone, but because Jesus Christ is real, present, and desires a living relationship with us. At Mass, He gives Himself to us in Word and Sacrament, strengthening us with His grace so that we may become more like Him and one day share eternal life with Him in heaven.

Practicing our faith is not meant to be limited to one hour a week. If faith remains only something we do at church or something we talk about, it quickly becomes disconnected from real life. Instead, our faith is meant to shape the way we think, act, love, forgive, and serve every day, in our homes, in our schools, in our workplaces, and in every relationship we have.

The goal of the Christian life is not simply to be informed, successful, or comfortable, but to be transformed. We are called to become saints: men, women, and children who live differently because Christ lives within them. Prayer, especially daily prayer, keeps our hearts connected to Jesus and helps us recognize where He is guiding us and where He is inviting us to grow.

In the end, the reason we practice our faith is love. God loves us first, and our response is to love Him in return—not only with words, but with our lives. When faith is lived daily and shared in our homes, it becomes a source of joy, purpose, and hope that carries us not only through this life, but into eternal life with God.

I want to share with you one way that I taught the students to welcome Jesus into your daily life. I told them: "take time each day, even if it's just 3-5 minutes to pray, open your heart to Jesus and ask Him to show you what things you did so far that day led you closer to Him, or what things you did that showed care or love for others, and thank him for helping you grow with him in those moments – and then at the same time ask Him to gently show you where He may have been calling you to handle things differently and to be more caring, compassionate, and helpful to others. So basically you just spend a few minutes asking Jesus to show you throughout your day where you united your heart with His, and where you didn't, so that in being aware of it you can strive to be more and more united with Him each day.

I encourage you to try it and to spend more time not learning about Jesus, but learning and encountering His love for YOU. Let Jesus love you, and enjoy His friendship, and you'll find that life and practicing your Faith becomes a lot more joy-filled, that life makes a lot more sense, and that the goal of everything becomes so much clearer. Let Jesus love you and see how it changes your life!




1st Tuesday Adoration
