From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke

Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

As you know, this past week Monday-Wednesday, myself and a group from the staff attended our next round of the "Great Catholic Parishes" workshop. It was amazing and not just eye opening but also HEART OPENING!
