## From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

This Wednesday we enter the holy season of Lent. My proposal for all of us this year is to view Lent as a journey of our heart. As ashes are placed on our foreheads, we'll hear the words, "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return." These solemn words are not meant to discourage us, but to awaken us. Lent is not simply about giving things up. It is about allowing God to lead us somewhere deeper.

The Church gives us forty days not as a spiritual endurance test, but as a grace-filled journey. And like any journey, it helps to know our destination. Life has so much more meaning and purpose when we're aware of what the goal of our efforts are!

Our goal is not merely to complete forty days of sacrifice. Our goal is transformation. By Easter, we desire hearts more deeply united to Jesus Christ: Hearts that love more freely, trust more completely, and follow Him more faithfully. But that kind of growth does not happen accidentally. It requires attention and intention.

As Lent begins, it is worth prayerfully asking:

Where do I sense God calling me to grow?

In what area of my life is He inviting me to deeper conversion?

What habits, fears, attachments, or patterns are blocking that growth?

Perhaps it is impatience in family life. Perhaps it is distraction in prayer. Perhaps it is anxiety, resentment, pride, or comfort-seeking. The Holy Spirit is gentle but persistent. Often, we already know where He is nudging us.

Growth in holiness is not primarily about doing more things. It is about removing obstacles that keep grace from bearing fruit. Sometimes the block is obvious: too much time on our phones, neglect of prayer, a lack of discipline, or an attachment to a sin that we're unwilling to give up. Other times it is interior: an unwillingness to forgive, a fear of surrender, or a quiet resistance to trusting God completely.

Lent is a gift because it gives us space to see clearly. Through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, we allow the light of Christ to reveal what needs healing. The beautiful thing is that once we have identified where God is calling us to grow, we can prayerfully make a plan. Not a grand, dramatic plan, but a faithful one. If we need deeper prayer, perhaps we commit to ten focused minutes each morning.

If we struggle with attachment, perhaps we fast from a comfort that has too strong a hold on us.

If charity is lacking, perhaps we intentionally practice one hidden act of love each day.

The key is not intensity, but consistency. Lent is walked one day at a time, with Jesus. When we stumble, we begin again. When we grow tired, we lean on His grace. The purpose is not self-improvement: it is deeper communion.

If we live Lent well and see it as an opportunity rather than a duty, then Easter will not simply be a celebration on the calendar. It will mark a real change within us. Our hearts will be more open. Our faith more alive. Our love more concrete.

And ideally, what begins in these forty days will continue long after they end. The habits we form, the insights we gain, and the surrender we practice can reshape the rest of our year and even the rest of our lives. As Ash Wednesday approaches, let us not ask only, "What should I give up?" Let us ask, "Lord, where are You calling me to grow? What stands in the way? And how can I walk toward You, step by step, this Lent?"

May this holy season lead us into a deeper friendship with Christ, one that transforms not just our Lenten practices, but our very hearts.

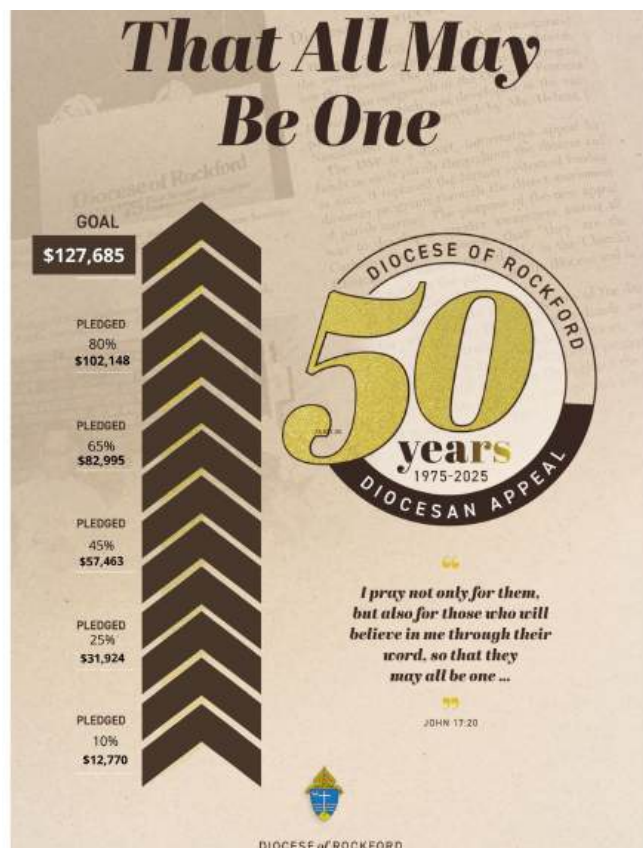

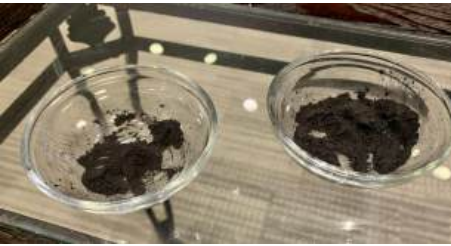
### Encounter with Fr. Romke

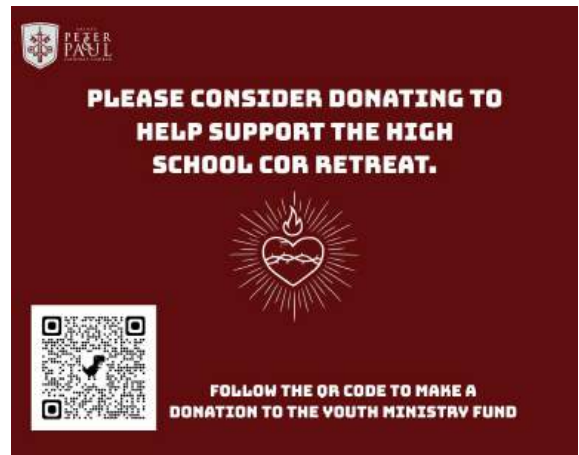

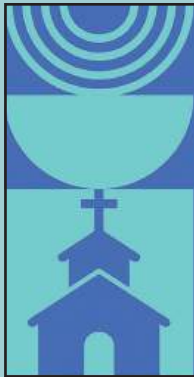
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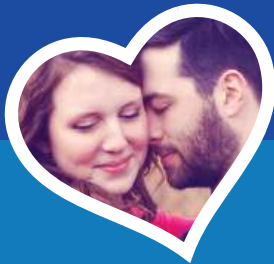
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
