From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

Happy Lent! I know it may seem strange to say “Happy” Lent when this seems to be a time when we’re holding back from things that make us happy, but Lent is honestly not about holding back from what makes us happy but instead giving ourselves the opportunity to take a step back from what makes us merely “happy” to instead attain true joy on a deeper level! If we simply “give stuff up” without the intention of having it create space within our time, minds, and hearts, then we’re missing the entire opportunity to grow and deepen our relationship with God. If your goal is to connect with God through this journey, and to take this journey WITH GOD, then it WILL happen and you will find joy – Not that it is a thing somewhere out there to be “found,” but it will emerge from within your heart where Jesus resides. Let’s do this!

I have a few ideas of ways to concretely strive to connect with God:

1. Often we can try to find the best, most life-changing thing that “gets the job done” in the quickest and most effective way. Well, even though you may have heard me speak about this before I’m going to say it again (and we’re going to offer it again!) that the “Light of the World Retreat” is a beautiful way to encounter the Heart of God and to experience His love for you in your life (which IS what we all want the most!) I will admit that I whole-heartedly know that it certainly involves an “investment” due to it being a weekend retreat, but I offer this thought: When we find a good investment, it will only benefit us to the level that we hand ourselves over to it. If you find or discover an incredible financial investment opportunity and simply toss \$25 towards it, then the opportunity won’t impact you to a degree that your life could potentially be impacted. This retreat is an opportunity that offers life-changing potential for your heart – but that will only happen if you choose to make the investment, and unlike with financial investments there’s truly no risk on this one. So PLEASE do your heart an amazing favor and give it what it wants and needs (You KNOW you yearn and ache for more!) The retreat is scheduled for March 21st, 22nd, and the evening of the 23rd. 2. A great way to hear God “Speak” is by reading His Word in the Bible. A few years back Fr. Mike Schmitz created his “Bible in a Year” podcast. Each day you read part of the Bible and then he gives a beautiful explanation so that you can delve deeper and really understand it and be fed by it. Each daily podcast takes 20-25 minutes a day (you can listen to it in the car!) and if you decide to start it, it’s a great way to ensure that you continue to grow even after Lent is finished, so it’s a great option if your desire is to really commit to your relationship with God and not just go through the motions for 40 days.
3. Take time each day with your family (or if you live on your own, find a friend that you could call each day to share with) to share what I like to call: “Rose, Thorn, and Seed.” Within this you simply share a blessing that you’re grateful for from the day – that’s your Rose, you also share something that was difficult and a struggle for you – that’s your “Thorn,” and finally share something that you’d like to ask the others to pray for you for – and that’s your “Seed!” It’s a great way to reflect and get in-touch with your heart and also to deepen the relationships with those around you!

I hope you all have an amazing Lent that has effects that last and continue to develop beyond Easter! Please pray for me this week as I am in Dunwoody, Georgia giving a Mission for my great friend, Fr. Michael Silloway’s, parish (he gave us our Lenten Mission here last year). Finally, mark your calendar for our own Parish Mission this year with Msgr. Deutsch, who was my pastor and mentor for my first 6 years of my priesthood when I was an associate before getting a parish of my own! He’ll be with us March 8th-10th at 7:00 pm each night.

Here we go!



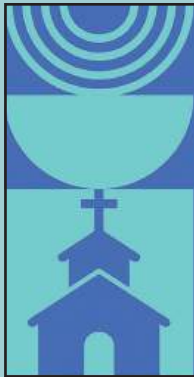

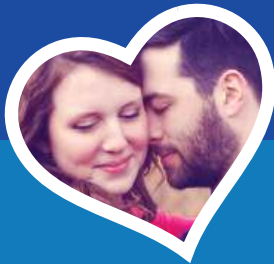
