## From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

As we journey further into the season of Lent, many of us begin to notice a familiar challenge. The enthusiasm we felt on Ash Wednesday when we first committed ourselves to prayer, fasting, and sacrifice can begin to fade. What started with strong intention may now feel more difficult to sustain. Our Lenten resolutions can slowly loosen, and it can be tempting to step back from the commitments we made. Yet this precise moment in the season is actually an invitation.

Lent is not about perfect performance. It is about transformation. The purpose of our sacrifices and resolutions is not simply to complete them successfully, but to allow them to draw us closer to the heart of the Lord. When we find ourselves struggling or drifting, it is not a sign that Lent is failing, rather, it may be the very moment when God is inviting us to go deeper.

Instead of becoming discouraged, we can gently return to the reason we began this journey: Love! Every small sacrifice, every moment of prayer, every effort to turn away from sin is an act of love offered to the One who loves us first.

One of the most powerful ways to renew our Lenten journey is to simply spend time with the Lord in quiet prayer. In the busyness of daily life, silence can be rare. Yet God often speaks most clearly when we step away from the noise and open our hearts to Him. Even a few minutes each day of quiet prayer can transform our spiritual lives. Sit with the Lord. Speak to Him honestly. Share your struggles, your hopes, and your gratitude. Then allow yourself to simply be present with Him. Scripture offers us a beautiful invitation: “Be still and know that I am God.”

I'll wholeheartedly admit that stillness is not always easy. Our minds race, our schedules pull at us, and distractions seem endless. But when we allow ourselves to slow down and rest in God's presence, we begin to rediscover the peace and strength that only He can give. This deeper stillness reminds us that Lent is not just about what we give up, it is about making space for God. When we clear away distractions, attachments, and habits that draw us away from Him, we create room in our hearts for His grace to work more fully.

If your Lenten practices have become difficult, do not give up. Begin again. The Lord is always ready to meet us where we are. Even the smallest step back toward Him can become a moment of grace. As we continue through this sacred season, let us renew our commitment not simply to our resolutions, but to the relationship they are meant to strengthen. May we seek moments of quiet prayer, open our hearts more fully to God, and rediscover the peace that comes from resting in His presence. In the stillness, we will find that He has been waiting for us all along.

God Bless you and I hope to see you at the mission Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday!




