## From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

I hope and pray that you are sensing some fruit growing in you as Lent progresses. It was such a gift having Msgr. Deutsch teach us about the true gift of Rest in God this past week at our mission. In case you missed it, don't worry, you can access the recorded videos on the parish YouTube account. I highly recommend it!

One incredibly beautiful way to dive deeper into your relationship with God is simply to spend time with Him. and to give Him the opportunity to encounter you! I probably sound like a broken record by now, but the reason why I'm willing to sound like one is because I myself know that "I am broken!" Not that I'm worthless or a failure, but I know that there are areas of my life that are broken that God wants to heal and pour His love into. I'm guessing you sense these areas in yourself as well. Giving God the time and space to heal you is the only way to heal, just like rest after surgery is needed for the whole thing to work!

PLEASE prayerfully consider attending the "Light of the World Retreat" next weekend (During the day Saturday, during the day Sunday, and then on Monday evening - and YES you get to go home and stay in the comfort of your own bed Saturday night). I've heard people in the past tell me that they don't feel called to go on the retreat and that they don't need it because they already were deeply impacted by other retreats like Curcillo, Emmaus, CRHP, Kairos, CAP, or COR, but my response to this would be: This fact means that you MORE than anyone should understand the impact a retreat can have on you and thus should come to the Light of the World Retreat with an open mind and open heart. I'm overjoyed if God spoke DEEPLY to you at a previous retreat, but God has new graces for us everyday and He's never done loving you. I'm going to go out on a limb and say that if you've enjoyed a family trip somewhere in your past, that when a new opportunity to get together in a new way arises, that you don't reject it because the other one was so great that you're set and don't need more now. God wants to give all of us, no matter if you've been on a retreat before or not, He wants to give us more NOW because He loves you NOW. So PLEASE pray about it, and PLEASE respond to God's call, because God has something unique for everyone at this retreat. [ssppevents.com/lotw](http://ssppevents.com/lotw)

Finally, one of the most beautiful ways that we can encounter the Lord is in Eucharistic Adoration, where we literally are in the presence of Jesus who comes to be with us. I'll explain more about this very soon, but for now I want to encourage coming to pray in the presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament on Tuesday evenings from 7-9. Spending time silently with the Lord is incredibly powerful and peaceful and would be a great way to enhance your lent!


