From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

I can't believe that Holy Week is just a week away! But before we get to that week, we will have our "Be Reconciled day" this Wednesday from 8:30am-7:00pm. Come anytime during that time frame and there will be a priest ready to hear your confession and reconcile your heart with the Heart of the Father!

Also, on Wednesday is when we'll embark as a parish on the 33 days to Eucharistic Glory Book, so make sure to pick up a copy today!

Then we'll get into Holy Week and I want to mention the events of that week ahead of time so that you can put it on your calendar and attend the Masses and services for the "Triduum" which means "Three days." These 3 holiest days of the year are Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Saturday which contains the Easter Vigil in the evening.

On Thursday the 2nd at 7:00 pm we celebrate the "Mass of the Lord's Supper" which commemorates and puts us into the scene of the Last Supper where Jesus instituted the Eucharist, washed the Apostles Feet, and ordained them to share in His Priesthood. This is an incredibly moving Mass which ends with a Eucharistic Procession, which calls to mind Jesus going from the Last Supper to the Garden of Gethsemane.

Then Friday the 3rd at 12:00 Noon we have the service called "The Passion of the Lord." In this service we remember and experience Jesus' sacrifice upon the cross. We will hear the story of the death of Jesus from St. John – which is my favorite Gospel! Following a set of intercessory prayers that invoke God's love and mercy upon the world, the cross will be ceremoniously brought forward, and at this point one by one each person in attendance will have the moving opportunity to come up and venerate the cross, kissing it which calls to mind that the wood of the cross was the instrument upon which our salvation was accomplished. Then we receive Our Lord in Communion.

Finally these incredibly rich liturgies conclude Saturday Evening at the Easter Vigil Mass on April 4th. The celebration of the Lord's Resurrection begins outside the Church, where a fire will be burning brightly, while most of the congregation awaits the arrival of the fire holding unlit candles inside the Church. When the fire arrives, the candles will be lit, symbolizing the fire of Faith that comes forth in the Resurrection of Jesus from the dead. This Mass will begin at 7:30 – because it is not allowed to begin until after sundown. Within the Mass there will be professions of Faith, Confirmations, and first communions. It is truly the most beautiful Mass of the year!

I hope to see you a LOT over the next couple of weeks!

Why do we cover the statues & Crucifix leading up to Holy Week?



WHY DO WE VEIL CRUCIFIXES & IMAGES DURING PASSIONTIDE?

Covering crosses, statues and images or "veiling" with unadorned violet opaque cloths begins on the Saturday before the 5th Sunday of Lent. It is an older custom of the Church that remains an option even to this day, it is also called 'fasting of the eyes.' While it may appear counterintuitive to veil statues and images during the final weeks of Lent, the Catholic Church recommends this practice to heighten our senses and build within us a longing for Easter Sunday.


