

From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

Congratulations on your Lenten Journey that you've made it to this point in! Just one week to go. As I say this I know that you may be proud of my statement of congratulations because you feel like you've had a great Lent with lots of felt growth. I also realize that you may be thinking to yourself that you don't feel worthy of being congratulated because you feel like you've coasted through Lent and that you didn't carry out your initial goals that you set out with on Ash Wednesday. No matter where you fall between these two opposites, I'm still congratulating you for making it to this point on the journey - because if you're reading this it means that you've made it to Mass which means that your heart is still open, that you're still trying, and you're still on the journey - THAT is what matters! Never quit. It doesn't matter how many times we fall, so long as we get back up with God's help (and we of course do need to try to make efforts to grow and avoid falling) So: CONGRATULATIONS for being on the journey no matter where you feel your at!

Holy week is a great time to encounter the Lord in a supercharged way!

I again invite you to participate in the Triduum which includes:

- The Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:00 Thursday evening
- The Good Friday Passion Service with veneration of the cross at noon on Friday
- The Easter Vigil Saturday night at 7:30

For the Easter vigil we'll be having an incredible group of amazing individuals receiving the sacraments of baptism, confirmation, and first Communion. It is so powerful and moving. The Mass usually runs about 2 hours, but it's better than any 2 hour movie that you could turn on or anything else that you could choose to do Saturday evening!

One of my favorite parts is when we sing the Gloria, which we haven't been singing throughout Lent. At this point in the Vigil Mass one of the Altar servers will ring the bells throughout the entire Gloria: I am inviting you to bring your own bells from home to participate in this beautiful and joyful moment. ***Bring a bell from home and ring away to your heart's desire joyfully celebrating the Resurrection!***

We've got just one week to go so let's pray and ask God to help us make it a good one!




