From the Desk of Fr. Keith Romke



Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

Happy Easter! Today is not just a day we remember something beautiful that happened long ago. Today is the day everything changes. The stone is rolled away, the tomb is empty, and death itself has been defeated. But here's the question for us: do we really live like that's true?

The first witnesses to the Resurrection didn't walk calmly away from the tomb. Scripture tells us that they ran. They didn't fully understand yet, but something inside them knew that this changes everything. I hope we sense this too and are willing to let it move us!

Because if Christ is truly risen (Which He is!) then: Our sins do not have the final word, our failures do not define us, our suffering is not meaningless, and death does not have the final word! And yet, many of us still live as if we are standing outside the tomb, unsure, hesitant, holding back. Easter invites us to do something bold: lean into the joy. Not a shallow happiness. Not a forced smile. But a deep, unshakable joy rooted in this truth: God has conquered everything that could separate us from Him.

But my guess is that sometimes we may hesitate because truly leaning into it and allowing ourselves to experience joy can feel risky. We might wonder what if it doesn't last? What if life gets hard again? What if I'm disappointed? So at times we hold back. We stay guarded. We keep one foot in the tomb, just in case. But the Resurrection doesn't allow for halfway living. When Mary Magdalene encountered the risen Christ, everything changed. When the apostles finally believed, they went from hiding in fear to proclaiming the Gospel to the world. They didn't play it safe, they leaned all the way in and so must we!

To lean into Easter joy means: Choosing hope even when life feels uncertain, trusting God is at work even when we don't see it, letting go of the sins and burdens we keep returning to, believing that new life is not just possible but that it's already begun! It also means allowing joy to transform how we live: Being people who forgive quickly, who love generously, who carry light into dark places, who live as witnesses that Christ is alive because the world desperately needs that witness.

There are so many people still living as if the tomb is full: trapped in despair, fear, and meaninglessness. And they are watching us. They are asking: Do these Christians really believe what they say? Our answer is not just in words. It's in our joy. Not perfection. Not constant happiness. But a deep, steady confidence: Christ is risen, and He is with me.

So today, don't stand at a distance from the empty tomb. Step inside. See that death has been defeated. Hear the words spoken to your own heart: "Do not be afraid."

And then run with the Grace of our risen Lord!

Finally, I'll be explaining more in the next couple of weeks but if you'd like to commit to an hour of Eucharistic Adoration during our "Adore" event April 27th - May 2nd scan this QR Code and sign-up to run to the Lord and spend time sharing in His life!

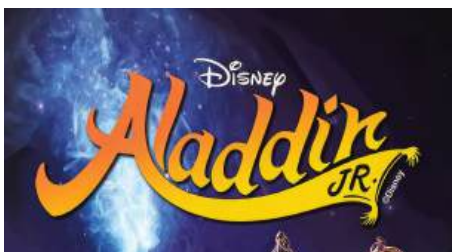
Divine Mercy Sunday

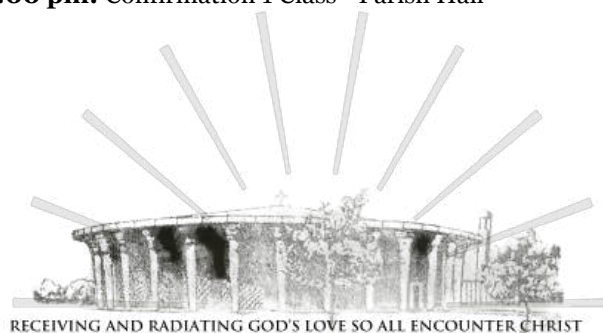
